DESCRIPTION: Under the general direction of the Division Reliability & Security, Chief of the Bureau of Emergency Management & Security or other supervisory official, handles all emergency management and preparedness functions involving the provision of critical utility services. This includes service disruptions, incidents, and catastrophic events, intentional acts and accidents.

Responsibilities include:

Learns to conduct routine surveys, studies, inspections, and/or investigations relating to the improvement and/or monitoring of environmental conditions, review of engineering plans, and/or enforcement of environmental laws/regulations.

Provides engineering support and technical assistance to Staff on Emergency Management projects.

Reviews periodic reports submitted by New Jersey Utility Companies.

Responds to utility emergency situations in the field.

Prepares technical engineering reports summarizing analyses and findings, which may include calculations, drawings, plans / specifications, diagrams, maps, spreadsheets, charts, and other technical information.

Maintains records, reports, and files, as appropriate.

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college with a Bachelor's degree in Civil, Chemical, Mechanical, Environmental, Ocean, Coastal, Bio-Resource, Sanitary, Industrial, Agricultural or Mining Engineering, or other field of engineering related to the environment.
