Request for Comments – July 12, 2019

The Staff of the Board of Public Utilities (BPU or Board) invite all interested parties and members of the public to submit written comments on the 1996 Uniform System of Accounts adopted by the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners and whether this model should be utilized in New Jersey to develop uniform accounting records and maintain consistent application for investor-owned water and wastewater (sewer) companies.

The Board's current Uniform System of Accounts for Wastewater (Sewer) Utilities was adopted effective April 1, 1957. The Board's Uniform System of Accounts for Water Utilities was adopted effective January 1, 1960. Staff seeks input from stakeholders regarding the Uniform System of Accounts for Water and Wastewater (Sewer) Utilities and provides this opportunity to discuss whether the current rules should be updated. Board Staff seeks comment on the 1996 Uniform System of Accounts adopted by the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners and whether this model should be utilized in New Jersey to develop uniform accounting records and maintain consistent application for investor-owned water and wastewater (sewer) utilities.
