ADOPTION OF THE PROGRAM YEAR 6 TECHNICAL REFERENCE MANUAL FOR NEW JERSEY'S TRIENNIUM 2 ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Staff of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("NJBP" or "Board") hereby invites all interested parties and members of the public to submit comments on a revised proposed Technical Reference Manual ("TRM") for the State's Energy Efficiency Triennium Program Year 6 ("PY6 TRM").

The TRM is a compendium of engineering equations and guidelines used to calculate the energy savings that arise from New Jersey's energy efficiency programs, including programs available through New Jersey's Clean Energy Program™ and public electric utility and public gas utility companies. The Board, through the TRM Committee, within the Evaluation, Measurement & Verification ("EM&V") Working Group established by the Board, manages the process by which the TRM is annually updated. The TRM Committee approved release for public comment of the PY6 TRM draft which, in turn, the EM&V Working Group approved on June 17, 2026.

The PY6 TRM is an evolution of the Energy Efficiency Triennium Program Year 5 TRM, with changes that address:²

- Editorial revisions, clarifications and error corrections
- Fixed reference links
- Implemented Evaluation Study results
- Added equipment for measure sections
- Updated parameter assumptions based on new secondary research
