

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
In the Matter of the Application for Renewal of a
System-Wide Cable Television Franchise for CSC TKR, LLC
BPU Docket No. CE25020029

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, pursuant to the “Cable Television Act,” N.J.S.A. 48:5A-16(f), the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“NJBP” or “Board”) hereby gives notice of virtual public hearings to discuss the application of CSC TKR, LLC (“Cablevision”) for a system-wide franchise (“SWF”) to add two (2) additional municipalities to its franchise territory, the Township of East Brunswick and the Borough of South River, located in Middlesex County, New Jersey.

Background

On February 11, 2010, the Board issued an order memorializing the conversion by CSC TKR of its municipal consent-based franchise in the Borough of Allentown to a System-wide cable television franchise for a term of seven (7) years. The Board issued subsequent renewals of the SWF on February 22, 2017, and March 19, 2025 (amended May 21, 2025, and December 17, 2025) for a term of seven (7) years, to expire on January 10, 2031, which included the addition of seven (7) municipalities to its SWF territory. Cablevision currently serves forty-four (44) municipalities under its SWF. On June 1, 2026, Cablevision filed an application to add two (2) additional municipalities to its franchise territory, the Township of East Brunswick and the Borough of South River, Middlesex County, New Jersey.
