

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
In the Matter of the Application for Renewal of a
System-Wide Cable Television Franchise for Cablevision of
Monmouth, LLC BPU Docket No. CE25020070

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, pursuant to the “Cable Television Act,” N.J.S.A. 48:5A-16(f), the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“NJBP” or “Board”) hereby gives notice of virtual public hearings to discuss the application of Cablevision of Monmouth, LLC (“Cablevision”) for a system-wide franchise.

Background

On February 19, 2025, Cablevision filed an application (“Application”) with the Board’s Office of Cable Television & Telecommunications, requesting the renewal of its system-wide franchise (“SWF”) to continue offering cable television service. On January 11, 2010, Cablevision converted its traditional municipal consent-based cable television franchise in the Borough of Interlaken into a SWF. Thereafter, on February 11, 2010, the Board issued a SWF to Cablevision for a term of seven (7) years. On February 22, 2017, the Board issued a renewal SWF television franchise to Cablevision, for a term of seven (7) years which expired on January 11, 2024. Since the initial Order, Cablevision has converted an additional nineteen (19) municipalities. The Cablevision SWF currently contains twenty (20) municipalities.
