Pursuant to the "Open Public Meetings Act", N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq., Staff of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("NJBPU" or "Board") offers this Notice to provide the public and interested parties the details of a virtual Stakeholder Meeting to be held on April 5, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. in the above-referenced docket.

The Board's Office of Cable Television and Telecommunications (Staff) is proposing rule amendments to N.J.A.C. 14:18 et seq., which rules are set to expire on September 30, 2021. An initial Stakeholder Meeting was conducted on February 4, 2021 to provide interested parties an opportunity to discuss the outline of recommended rule modifications provided by Staff. A draft rule proposal with recommended changes from Staff, which includes modifications updating the rules to reflect technological changes, Federal Communications Commission changes that have taken place in the last several years, and the implementation of customer service metrics and enforcement measures associated with noncompliance will be posted on the Board's website prior to the meeting at <u>www.nj.gov/bpu/agenda/rules</u>. In addition, comments filed in this matter suggesting recommended changes will also be discussed.
