Notice of Public Hearings

**In the Matter of the Verified Petition of Jersey Central Power & Light Company for
Approval of Rate Adjustments Pursuant to the JCP&L Infrastructure Investment
Program II(“EnergizeNJ”) (October 2025 Energize NJ Filing)**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on October 15, 2025, Jersey Central Power & Light Company (“JCP&L” or “Company”) filed a verified petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“Board”) seeking approval of a rate adjustment pursuant to the Infrastructure Investment Program (“EnergizeNJ”, (“ENJ”) or “Program”) (“Petition”).

By Order dated April 23, 2025, the Board authorized JCP&L to implement EnergizeNJ which consists of a total authorized capital investment of up to \$202,537,239 over three-and-one-half (3.5) years in ten (10) eligible electric distribution infrastructure projects, grouped into three (3) Program categories: grid modernization, system resiliency, and substation modernization.

The Company will also maintain capital expenditures of \$20 million [equal to ten percent (10%) of actual spend] on similar projects over the same duration pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:3-2A.2(c) and additional capital expenditures of \$112 million for matching projects (with no specified annual amounts) to be completed by the end of the Program.

JCP&L, by this initial rate adjustment filing, seeks Board approval to recover the revenue requirements associated with the capitalized investment costs of EnergizeNJ through January 31, 2026. The annualized increase in revenue requirements is approximately \$2.4 million.

The Company proposes to recover the revenue requirements associated with the Program through base rate adjustment filings (*i.e.*, base rate roll-ins) no more frequently than a semi-annual basis, consistent with the II&R Rules.¹ The Company’s initial filing for the first recovery period, if approved, will result in an estimated bill impact to the typical residential customer who uses 777 kWh per month of \$0.10 per month, or 0.1%, based on rates effective as of July 15, 2026.

The following illustrative charts show the estimated monthly bill impacts, in both dollars and percentages, to residential customers of various usage levels and to overall average customers of all rate classes based upon a comparison of current and proposed rates and the approximate net effect of the proposed increases. For the “Residential Average Bill,” the “Current Monthly Bill” is calculated using the product of the customer’s usage at the stated level multiplied by all applicable rates in effect as of July 15, 2026, by season and block during the twelve (12)-month period, including the monthly fixed customer charge, divided by twelve (12). For “Overall Class Average Per Customer,” the “Current Monthly Bill” is calculated using the product of all

customers' total usage in each class multiplied by all applicable current rates that are in effect as of July 15, 2026, by season and block (if applicable), including monthly fixed customer charges (fixture charges for the lighting class) during the twelve (12) -month period, divided by the number of customers and months in that class. The "Proposed Monthly Bill" for both "Residential" and "Overall Class Average" customers are calculated in the same manner, except that the proposed ENJ rate is used instead of the current ENJ rate (*i.e* zero, currently). The actual effect on specific customers will vary according to the applicable rate schedule and level of the customer's usage.
