IN THE MATTER OF THE CLEAN ENERGY PROGRAMS AND BUDGETS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 – TRUE-UP, REVISED BUDGETS AND PROGRAM CHANGES

TAKE NOTICE THAT pursuant to the “Open Public Meetings Act,” N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq., the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“NJBPU” or “Board”) is requesting written comments on the New Jersey Clean Energy Programs and Budgets for Fiscal Year 2021 – True-up, Revised Budgets and Program Changes. These budget revisions are intended to reconcile the estimated expenses and commitments made in Fiscal Year 2020 and to “true-up” the differences.

NJBPU Staff [released](#) the Proposed NJCEP FY21 True-up Budget, Budget Revisions and Program Changes for public comment on February 23, 2021. **NJBPU is extending the comment period deadline, originally set for March 9, 2021. Comments will now be accepted through 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 11, 2021.**



Commenters are encouraged to file comments electronically through the Board’s External Access Portal upon obtaining a MyNewJersey Portal ID.
