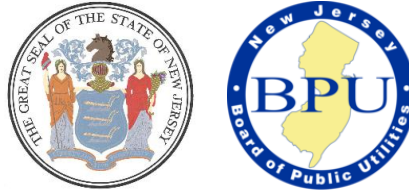

Pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq., the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (NJBPU or Board) hereby gives notice and invites all interested parties and members of the public to participate in a virtual public hearing to discuss the Fiscal Year 2027 (“FY27”) Straw Proposal for New Jersey’s Clean Energy Program (“NJCEP”) Comprehensive Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Resource Analysis (“CRA”) and the proposed FY27 program budgets and compliance filings.

Through the CRA process, the NJCEP funding levels for energy efficiency and Class I renewable energy programs are established. The proposed funding level will fund the core NJCEP programs and provide opportunities for new and enhanced programs that help residents, businesses, and State and local governments reduce energy usage, save money, and improve the environment.

The 1999 Electric Discount and Energy Competition Act (“EDECA”) established a Societal Benefits Charge (“SBC”) to fund programs for the advancement of energy efficiency and Class I renewable energy technologies and markets in New Jersey.² Governor Sherrill, in Executive Orders 1 and 2,³ specifically calls for the Board to lower ratepayer bills and bring online new generation. The FY27 NJCEP Budget and CRA lays out how the Board aims to meet these goals through programs funded by the SBC.
