PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on November 9, 2023, New Jersey Natural Gas Company ("NJNG" or "Company") filed a letter petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") seeking approval to extend by six (6) months, the energy efficiency ("EE") programs previously approved by the Board to be implemented for a three-year period from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024 ("Triennium 1" or "TI"). The EE programs were proposed by NJNG and approved by the Board in accordance with the Clean Energy Act of 2018 ("CEA"). NJNG is seeking approval for a budget of \$76.929 million for the sixmonth extension. The Petition states that the requested budget is designed to meet customer demand for the Company's current Triennium 1 Program.

NJNG's TI programs were approved by Board Order on March 2, 2021. By Order dated May 24, 2023, the Board directed each electric and gas public utility to propose EE programs for Triennium 2 ("T2") on or before October 2, 2023. On October 25, 2023, the Board found it was reasonable, prudent, and in the public interest to provide additional time for Board Staff ("Staff") and the New Jersey Division of Rate Counsel to conduct a thorough and diligent concurrent review of the T2 filings, as well as to provide parties and interested stakeholders with additional time to review, analyze, and discuss the filings. As a result, the Board ordered that T2 programs would commence on January 1, 2025, concluding on June 30, 2027, and directed the electric and gas utilities to each file a petition to extend their T1 programs by six (6) months to December 31, 2024.

According to the Petition, NJNG will seek recovery of the costs in future annual rate filings through its EE Rider F, which recovers costs associated with EE programs ("Programs") offered through the Company's Board-approved SAVEGREEN™ Program. The current Programs provide a broad range of EE offerings for residential, commercial, and industrial customers, including special resources for low to moderate income customers. The Programs include discounted energy saving measures, grants, financing opportunities, technical assistance, and other resources to help address barriers to saving energy and making investments in energy efficiency improvements more accessible for all customers. Pursuant to Board Orders dated July 17, 2009 (Docket Nos. EO09010056 and EO09010057), September 24, 2010 (Docket No. GO10030225), January 18, 2012 (Docket No. GR11070425), June 21, 2013 (GO12070640), July 22, 2015 and June 29, 2016 (Docket No. GO14121412), September 17, 2018 (Docket No. GO18030355), and March 3, 2021 (Docket Nos. Q019010040 and G020090622), NJNG is authorized to recover all reasonable and prudent costs associated with the SAVEGREEN programs. The approved and proposed costs include funds for grants, customer incentives and the associated incremental Operations and Maintenance expenses, along with associated carrying costs.
