## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

## IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF ELIZABETHTOWN GAS COMPANY FOR APPROVAL OF A RATE ADJUSTMENT PURSUANT TO THE INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT PROGRAM ("IIP") BPU Docket No. GR20050327

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, on April 30, 2020, as modified on July 15, 2020, Elizabethtown Gas Company ("Elizabethtown" or "Company") filed a petition (Petition) with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") seeking Board approval to increase rates associated with the Company's Infrastructure Investment Program ("IIP"). The Board approved the IIP and the associated cost recovery mechanism on June 12, 2019 in Docket No. GR18101197 ("Order"). The Order authorized the Company to invest up to \$300 million, over a five-year period, commencing July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2024, to replace up to 250 miles of cast iron and bare steel mains and related services, as well as the installation of excess flow valves on new service lines ("IIP Projects"). The IIP Projects are intended to enhance distribution safety and reliability to the benefit of Elizabethtown's customers, to help support the environment, and to facilitate economic development and employment in New Jersey. The Order also authorized the Company to make annual filings with the Board to recover the costs associated with the IIP Projects investments and to earn a return on and a return of those investments through annual adjustments to rates. This Petition seeks Board approval to recover \$6.8 million of revenue requirements associated with approximately \$62.8 million of IIP Projects placed in-service from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 with an October 1, 2020 rate effective date.

If the proposed rate increase is approved by the Board, effective October 1, 2020, the rates, inclusive of taxes, to all firm customers served under Service Classifications RDS, SGS, GDS, NGV, LVD, EGF, and GLS including certain firm, Board approved special contract customers served under the Company's firm rate classes would be as follows:

The rates are subject to BPU approval and may be higher or lower depending on the Board's final determination and the date on which such rate is made effective.

The impact of the proposed rate increase to the residential heating customer using 100 therms is to increase the customer's monthly bill by \$2.10 from \$106.14 to \$108.24, an increase of 2.0% compared to the Company's present rates.

Any assistance required by Customers in ascertaining the impact of the proposed rate increase will be provided by the Company upon request.
