IN THE MATTER OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF $\underline{P.L.}$ 2018, c.17 - ENERGY AND WATER BENCHMARKING OF COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS

Pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq., the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("NJBPU" or "Board") hereby gives notice and invites all interested parties and members of the public to participate in a virtual Stakeholder Meeting regarding the impact of the New Jersey Building Energy and Water Benchmarking Program ("Program") upon non-regulated electric and water utilities.

On May 23, 2018, Governor Phil Murphy signed the Clean Energy Act into law as <u>L.</u> 2018, <u>c.</u> 17 ("Clean Energy Act of 2018"). The Clean Energy Act of 2018 mandates the following:

No later than five years after the date of enactment of P.L.2018, c.17 (C.48:3-87.8 et al.), the board shall require the owner or operator of each commercial building over 25,000 square feet in the State to benchmark energy and water use for the prior calendar year using the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Portfolio Manager tool.

The 2019 New Jersey Energy Master Plan ("EMP") includes Goal 3.3.2, to "Establish transparent benchmarking and energy labeling," which lists building energy use benchmarking as a critical component in promoting market-driven increases in energy efficiency. Benchmarking allows commercial building owners and operators to measure and analyze their respective facilities' energy and water use and compare their performance to similar buildings. Owners and operators can then assess opportunities for performance improvements that reduce their respective building's energy and water use.

The Board approved the Program on September 7, 2022. The Board Order outlines the general procedures and requirements for this Program. More information is available at the Board's benchmarking website.
