**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that, on December 16, 2025, Veolia Water New Jersey, Inc. (“Company” or “Veolia”) filed a petition (“Petition”) with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“Board” or “BPU”) pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:1-5.1, N.J.A.C. 14:1-5.5, and other related statutes and regulations, to expand its franchise area in the Township of Byram in the County of Sussex (“Township”), to include the residents within the East Brookwood area of the Township (“East Brookwood”), which it currently serves in certain parts. Specifically, Veolia is seeking Board approval of Ordinance No. 015-2025 adopted by the Township on November 5, 2025. The Company also seeks the authority to incorporate this franchise area into the Company’s tariff which sets forth the Company’s expanded service area.

If the Petition is approved, there will be no rate changes implemented by the Company as a result of the Board’s approval of the Petition, and therefore rates will remain the same.
