

**NOTICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF HOPEWELL BOROUGH AND OTHER
INTERESTED PARTIES OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF NEW JERSEY-AMERICAN WATER
COMPANY FOR APPROVAL OF A MUNICIPAL CONSENT GRANTED BY
HOPEWELL BOROUGH, MERCER COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, on February 10, 2026, New Jersey-American Water Company, Inc. (“NJAWC” or “Company”) filed a petition (“Petition”) with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“Board”) pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-14, N.J.A.C. 14:1-5.5, and such other regulations and statutes as may be deemed applicable and appropriate by the Board, for approval of a municipal consent ordinance (“Ordinance 908”) granted to NJAWC by the Borough of Hopewell (“Borough”). The municipal consent was granted in anticipation of the sale of the Borough’s potable water system to NJAWC as part of a sale process conducted in compliance with and pursuant to the procedures set forth pursuant to the provisions of the Water Infrastructure Protection Act, N.J.S.A. 58:30-1 et seq. (“WIPA”).

The Township adopted Ordinance 908 on February 5, 2026, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:3-11 through 48:3-15, N.J.S.A. 48:19-17, N.J.S.A. 48:19-20, and N.J.S.A. 48:13-11, granting municipal consent to NJAWC to construct, lay, maintain and operate the necessary water mains, pipes and appurtenances throughout the Borough (“Proposed Franchise Area”) and to provide water services to the Proposed Franchise Area.

NO INCREASE IN RATES WILL RESULT FROM APPROVAL OF THE PETITION. The ratemaking treatment relative to the acquisition was approved by the Board in Docket No. WM25040191. Pursuant to the Board’s June 18, 2025 Order, upon closing of the sale of the system, NJAWC will bill Borough residents for general metered water service in accordance with its Rate Schedule A-1, including all applicable tariff schedules and surcharges, which include NJAWC’s distribution system improvement charge, purchased water adjustment clause, special program charge, lead service line replacement charge and resiliency and environmental system investment charge. NJAWC will bill Borough private fire customers in accordance with its Rate Schedule L-13 and Borough public fire customers in accordance with Rate Schedule M-12.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that a virtual public hearing on the Petition has been scheduled for **May 21, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.**, which will be presided over by a hearing officer designated by the Board.
