

The New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission ("NJ-CRC" or "Commission") has received and reviewed your application requesting approval of an ownership transfer by which minority owners Christopher Thomas Lloyd (44.1%) and Vishal R. Patel (4.9%) would be removed and replaced by Aman Verma (24.5%) and Singh Inderpal (24.5%). Majority owner Leonilda Rodriguez would retain her 51% equity in the company and the company would remain designated as a minority and woman-owned business enterprise. Your application has been approved.

All proposed ownership transfers in the personal-use cannabis market must comply with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 17:30, et seq, including the ownership transfer requirements under N.J.A.C. 17:30-9.3. After completing a thorough investigation of your entity, Commission staff found no evidence that would preclude the proposed transfer of ownership, and no significant derogatory information was uncovered during the investigations that would impact the suitability of the individuals or entities investigated. Thus, your proposed transfer of ownership is approved.
