## RESOLUTION 2025-<u>02-18-05</u> CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS TO CONVERT FROM MICROBUSINESSES TO STANDARD CANNABIS BUSINESSES

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission ("the Commission"), established pursuant to P.L. 2019, c.153, known and cited as the "Jake Honig Compassionate Use Medical Cannabis Act," is charged with implementing the provisions of that Act as well as P.L.2021, c.16, known and cited as the "New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act"; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 19, 2021, the Commission adopted rules pursuant to N.J.S.A. 24:6I-36(f)(3) that established the process for a microbusiness to apply to convert to a standard cannabis business; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.15 outlines the application process and requirements for a microbusiness to convert to a standard cannabis business; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.15, the microbusiness must be operational for at least one year prior to applying for conversion and be in good standing with the Commission and submit all required application materials set forth in N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.15; and

WHEREAS, for any applications deemed incomplete in any respect, the application was sent back to the applicant with direction on how to appropriately cure any deficiencies in the application; and

**WHEREAS**, the microbusinesses listed below have submitted applications to convert to standard cannabis businesses, have cured their application as necessary, have passed review by Commission staff, and are recommended by Commission staff for approval;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission pursuant to N.J.S.A. 24:6I-36(f)(3) and N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.15, the following microbusinesses have satisfied the requirements set forth in regulation, and the Commission has determined to approve the applications to convert to a standard cannabis business, pending payment of the requisite fees in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.17:
