## RESOLUTION 2025-10-01-15 CONDITIONAL RENEWAL OF ADULT-USE CANNABIS BUSINESS LICENSE

**WHEREAS**, the authority to regulate and enforce activities related to medicinal cannabis previously was vested in the New Jersey Department of Health ("the Department"), and now vests in the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission ("the Commission") pursuant to P.L. 2019, c.153; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 24:6I-35(a)(1) of the Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act, N.J.S.A. 24:6I-31 et seq., ("the Act"), the Commission shall adopt rules and regulations, which include "[p]rocedures for the application, issuance, denial, renewal, suspension, and revocation of a license or conditional license to operate as a cannabis establishment, distributor, or delivery service"; and

WHEREAS, the Commission previously approved and issued an adult-use cannabis business license to the following expanded Alternative Treatment Centers ("ATC"):

**WHEREAS**, adult-use cannabis business license holders are required to submit a renewal application in compliance with N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.16; and

**WHEREAS**, adult-use cannabis business license holders are required to pay the requisite renewal fees pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.17, as applicable; and

**WHEREAS,** N.J.A.C. 17:30-9.4(g) states "[t]he maintenance of a labor peace agreement with a bona fide labor organization by a licensed cannabis business, including an expanded ATC,

shall be an ongoing material condition of the cannabis business's license"; and

**WHEREAS,** as of October 1, 2025, Curaleaf NJ II Inc. ("Curaleaf") has not provided the Commission with a valid, executed labor peace agreement. Additionally, in its renewal application submitted on August 1, 2025, Curaleaf stated that it was not in compliance with the statutory and regulatory requirement to maintain a labor peace agreement with a bona fide labor organization;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission pursuant to N.J.S.A. 24:6I-35(a)(1) and N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.16, the Commission has determined to conditionally approve the renewal of the personal-use cannabis business licenses as set forth below, subject to the entity satisfying the following condition and pending the payment of the requisite renewal fees pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.17:

• Conditions: No later than October 30, 2025, Curaleaf shall provide the NJ-CRC with a valid, executed labor peace agreement with a bona fide labor organization in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:30-9.4(g).

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission that if Curaleaf complies with the above condition, its retailer license will be renewed for an additional year. However, if Curaleaf fails to satisfy the requirement by the stated date, it will be deemed as having failed to maintain compliance with applicable laws or regulations. As such, license number RE000009 will not be renewed and will expire on October 30, 2025. Upon expiration of the license, Curaleaf must cease all cannabis activities being conducted under license number RE000009. Expiration of license number RE000009 would not affect Curaleaf's medical cannabis permit (permit number MRE000808).
