The New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission ("NJ-CRC" or "Commission") has received and reviewed your application requesting approval of an ownership transfer by which majority owner

No new owners are proposed to be added, and all existing owners were previously vetted and determined to be qualified by the NJ-CRC, with no derogatory information found. The entity commenced operations on May 3, 2023, and therefore, this transfer is complaint with N.J.A.C. 17:30-9.3(a) as the entity has been operational for more than two years. Your application has been approved.

All proposed ownership transfers in the personal-use cannabis market must comply with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 17:30, et seq, including the ownership transfer requirements under N.J.A.C. 17:30-9.3. After completing a thorough investigation of your entity, Commission staff found no evidence that would preclude the proposed transfer of ownership, and no significant derogatory information was uncovered during the investigations that would impact the suitability of the individuals or entities investigated. Thus, your proposed transfer of ownership is approved.
