RESOLUTION 2025-12-17-13

ADMINISTRATIVE EXTENSION OF CURALEAF NJ II, INC.

ALTERNATIVE TREATMENT CENTER PERMIT NOS:

MC000405, MC000404, MM000204, MRE000810, MRE000809, MRE000808

WHEREAS, P.L.2019, c.153, "Jake Honig Compassionate Use Medical Cannabis Act," ("the Act") authorizes a process for receipt of applications and issuance of permits to operate Alternative Treatment Centers ("ATCs") in the state of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the authority to regulate and enforce activities related to medicinal cannabis previously was vested in the New Jersey Department of Health ("the Department"), and now vests in the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission ("the Commission") pursuant to P.L. 2019, c.153; and

WHEREAS, the regulations for medicinal cannabis provide a process at N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.6 and N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.7 for renewals of ATC permits; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.7(b), "[t]he permit period for an [ATC] shall be from January 1st (or the date of approval of the application, if later) through December 31st of a given year"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.6, an ATC must renew its permit at the end of each year when the ATC has been in operation for a minimum of one (1) year; and

WHEREAS, an ATC that has been in operation for one (1) year or longer is required to submit a full renewal application with fees, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.7 and N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.10; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.7(a), ATCs are required to submit their renewal application 60 days prior to the expiration of the permit; and

WHEREAS, the Commission reviews the renewal application to verify that there are no material changes made that would otherwise require approval under N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.8; that the ATC is in compliance with the regulations governing the management, operation, and financing of the ATC; and that the ATC will continue to prioritize service to the medicinal patient population and will continue to remain in compliance with post-award conditions set forth in their Final Agency Decision; and

WHEREAS, the Commission must review medical cannabis permit renewal applications for completeness and accuracy and for material factors that could impact the renewal or extension of the permit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission that, due ongoing litigation in the matter of Curaleaf Holdings, Inc., et al. v. N.J. Cannabis Regulatory Commission, et al. Civil Action No. 3:25-cv-16397-MAS-RLS, the Commission hereby grants an administrative extension of the Curaleaf NJ II, Inc. medicinal cannabis permits listed below until March 31, 2026, by which time the Commission will reassess whether to grant additional administrative extensions or render a final decision on the permit renewals.


