Licensing Update – Total Licenses Approved

- as of July 29, 2026

- **Total 3,255 applications submitted**
- 2,555 applications have been approved
- 8 applications are under review in the Office of Licensing
- 140 applications are pending resubmission following cure
- 98 applications under review in the Office of Compliance & Investigations

Notice of Enforcement Action



INV Number	Entity Name	Violation
INV-55-2026	Mister Jones LLC	Failure to adhere to the statute and Adult Use regulations by advertising its cannabis business without reliable evidence that at least 50% of the audience for the advertisement was reasonably expected to be 21 years of age or older; advertising its cannabis business at and in connection with a sports event without reliable evidence that no more than 20% of the audience at the event was reasonably expected to be under the legal age to purchase cannabis; advertising its cannabis business on a poster in an arena or stadium that did not prohibit persons under 21 year of age from entering; and failing to keep records as reliable evidence that its advertisements met the requirement of the statute and Adult Use regulations

INV-31-2026	Mountain Dispensary	Failure to adhere to the Adult Use regulations by effectuating an ownership change prior to Board approval, and for failing to provide truthful, correct, and current information on its annual renewal application

INV Number	Entity Name	Violation
INV-64-2026	Green Analytics East LLC	Failure to adhere to the statute and Adult Use regulations by failing to conform with the Maryland Testing Standards adopted by the Commission; restricting the Commission’s required remote access to its video-surveillance system; collecting insufficient and non-representative initial samples; failing to report stability-testing results within the required 14-day period; utilizing non-validated methods for microbial testing and failing to perform required plating procedures; failing to properly test edible cannabis products in final form; and failing to maintain required sample traceability.

INV Number	Entity Name	Violation
INV-65-2026	Culture Craft Cannabis Collective LLC	Failure to adhere to the Adult Use regulations by extending the expiration date of usable cannabis without properly conducting the required stability testing and without obtaining the necessary authorization from the Commission. Additionally, Culture Craft Cannabis Collective labels displayed incorrect harvest and expiration dates.
