RESOLUTION 2026-08-06-08
MOTION TO APPROVE SETTLEMENT
HASHERY LLC UNDER INV 09-2026

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission (“the Commission”), established pursuant to P.L.2019, c.153, known and cited as the “Jake Honig Compassionate Use Medical Cannabis Act,” is charged with implementing the provisions of that Act as well as P.L.2021, c.16, known and cited as the “New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act”; and

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2026, NJ-CRC issued Hashery LLC (“Hashery”) a Revised Notice of Enforcement Action, imposing a civil monetary penalty of \$20,000.00 for utilizing an unapproved RV for advertisement, displaying cannabis paraphernalia in a manner that was visible to the public, storing cannabis product in an unsecure area, preventing the clear monitoring of activity within the vault, and failing to update its cannabis product inventories on at least a daily basis; and

WHEREAS, the parties have voluntarily agreed to settle the Notice of Enforcement Action; and

WHEREAS, the Commission now votes to act consistently with the discussion it had in executive session and the recommendation made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission, that the settlement agreement with Hashery to resolve INV 09-2026 is hereby **APPROVED**. **It is FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chair and Executive Director have joint authority to sign the agreement on behalf of the Commission.
