Just to confirm, you are referring to the attachments in NJSA 47:1A-3.a Ongoing Investigations Part A Endorsed Final.pdf?

If so, there are files that have the same issue as in other submissions, the document was corrupted before it was attached and it cannot be opened. They are corrupted files and are not zip files or zip files that were just changed to end in ".PDF".

If you open the files in Notepad to see the raw content of the corrupted files, none of them start with "%PDF-1", this is the standard first line for all PDF files. Whatever tool they used before adding them to our part A document corrupted them before they were attached. I also observed that the corrupted files all have an very similar text value in Notepad. We opened a high priority ticket with Adobe and had Adobe investigate and they came to the conclusion that the file was not recoverable for a similar submission. I also tried everything I could to open the files, but I was unable to open any of the files for that RFA.
