Priority Applications for cannabis business licenses



Priority cannabis business applications are reviewed ahead of all other applications. Among priority applicants, Social Equity business applications are considered first, then Diversely-owned businesses, then Impact Zone businesses. Follow the color-coded guide to see your priority application designation and the required documents to support your application. **Pick the designation that gives you the highest priority.**

Am I a social Equity Applicant?

You are if:

- you currently live in, or have you lived in an Economically Disadvantaged Area or
- you have been convicted of a marijuana/hashishrelated offense

Is my business a Diversely-owned Business?

It is if:

- your business is registered in NJ and
- You have certification from the NJ Department of the Treasury as a minorityowned, woman-owned, disabled veteranowned business

Is my business an Impact Zone Business?

It is if:

- you intend to locate your business in an Impact Zone, or
- you live in an Impact Zone, or
- You intend to hire staff who live in an Impact Zone

 A sworn, notarized statement attesting to your social equity status.

AND

- Documentation proving you live/lived in an Economically Disadvantaged Area for 5 of the 10 preceding years AND
- Proof your income is 80% or less than the state's average median income.

OR

• Documentation of past marijuana/hashish convictions (e.g., court, probation and expungement documents, criminal background check.)

What do I need to show my priority designation?

 Certification(s) from the Department of the Treasury's Division of Revenue and Enterprise Services proving the business has qualified as a minority -owned business, woman-owned business or a disabled veteran-owned business.



SCAN WITH CAMERA. NO APP NEEDED. Proof that more than 50% of the business is owned by a resident in an Impact Zone for at least 3 consecutive years.

OR

• Application with intended business address in an Impact Zone.

OR

• Present a plan for hiring employees who reside in an Impact Zone.
