

WHAT IS A **CERTIFICATE OF ANALYSIS (COA)** FOR CANNABIS PRODUCTS?

A Certificate of Analysis (CoA) is a lab report that details the safety, quality, and potency of a cannabis product. The NJ-CRC requires all cannabis products to be tested by a licensed third-party laboratory before sale, and that the results are detailed in a CoA. Testing ensures products for sale are free from harmful contaminants and accurately labeled to show the potency of THC, CBD, and other cannabinoids.




