

Know Before You Go

Welcome to New Jersey's Medicinal Cannabis Program (MCP). A medicinal patient or caregiver should plan before visiting one of the licensed dispensaries. Dispensaries offer a wide range of cannabis products, from flower to tinctures, concentrates, and lozenges. If you are unsure which one is right for you, ask a knowledgeable budtender for help.

Where can I find a list of licensed New Jersey dispensaries?

A list of dispensaries can be found at **njcrcgov.info/dispensary**. You can for the dispensaries by "type" if you are looking for a dispensary specifically for medicinal cannabis patients.

What do I need to take with me when visiting the dispensary as a patient?

You must present your current state-issued ID and your MCP ID to qualify to purchase from a dispensary's medicinal menu and state tax exemption.

Can I find out what type of products are available at a dispensary before visiting?

Many dispensaries provide an online menu of available products and pricing with the option to order directly from their website.

Can I purchase at a recreational-only dispensary as a medical patient?

Yes, you can shop at a recreational-only dispensary as a medical patient. However, your MCP ID may not be honored, and your purchase will be taxed as an adult-use transaction.

Can I print my digital MCP ID from my patient or caregiver portal and present the printed copy at a dispensary?

Yes, you can either print the PDF from your portal to show at the dispensary or you may present the digital MCP ID in your portal if you don't have or forgot a physical MCP ID.

How can I report accidental cannabis poisoning?
