Jim Thebery mentioned he sent letters to the Governor and Assembly speaker for appointments to the Casino Revenue Fund Advisory Committee.

Derek DeLuca added the need for (1) appointment for Assembly (R) and (2) appointments for speakers – disabled.

Jim Carney stated Atlantic City has the highest foreclosure rate in New Jersey. Casinos closed, businesses closed and there are challenges that have not been addressed by government and communities. However, with the (2) new casinos opening, and Stockton University the outcome could be positive.

Jim Thebery – Hard Rock & Ocean Club Resort will be opening this summer. Both will be offering Internet betting. Waiting for decision on the sports betting. Decision should be made by May 2018.

What's happening in AC

REVEL – has been sold to AC Ocean Walk, a group led by Colorado based investor Bruce Deifik. Scheduled to open summer of 2018.

Hard Rock – Partners Jim Allen, Jack Morris and Joe Jingoli are investing for a complete make-over of the former Trump Taj Mahal property. Hard Rock is scheduled to open summer 2018. This project will create more than 3,000 permanent jobs and will feature 165,000 sq. feet of meeting and convention space as well as, 5,700 concert seating space.

Steel Pier Observation Wheel – Steel Pier's 227 foot tall observation wheel opened in December 2017. The \$14 million project (200 ft observation wheel) includes 42 enclosed climate-controlled gondolas on their existing deck and is open year round.

Stockton University – Campus will be located at the intersections of Atlantic, Albany and Pacific Avenues. The grand opening is scheduled for the fall of 2018. This will include: a housing and student center on the Boardwalk for 500+ students, a parking garage and academic building for up to 1,800 students.
