The main objective of this meeting was to finalize the CRFAC Annual Report to present to the Legislators & Governor Murphy.

AC HIGHLIGHTS: (taken from LIGHT – Levenson Institute of Gaming, Hospitality & Tourism at Stockton University)

MAY:

The first quarter continue to show positive revenue trends in the Casino, Rooms and Food & beverage segments. Casino revenue is up 17.6%, Rooms revenue is up 23% and Food and Beverage revenue is up approx. 24%. While GOP increased by about 15% when compared to the 4th quarter, it is down 29% compared to the first quarter in 2018. Total gamin revenue for

the month of May (\$266.76M) and the year-to-date (\$1.24 billion) is up 22.5% and 21.1 % respectively.
