Subsequent to the reading of a statement of compliance with the notice requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act and identification of items discussed during closed session, the Commission considered and took formal action on the following matters:

Petition of HR Atlantic City, LLC for the issuance of a statement of compliance pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-81a(1) (PRN 0371402).

The Commission received into evidence the following exhibits: A-1 and A-2 from HR Atlantic City, LLC ("Petitioner"), and D-1 and D-2 from the Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division").

By a vote of 3-0, approved the Petitioners' sealing request and redacted portions of exhibit D-1.

The Commission received opening statements from Nicholas Casiello, Esq., Counsel for HR Atlantic City, LLC; and John Adams, Deputy Attorney General, for the Division of Gaming Enforcement.

The Commission heard the presentation of Petitioner and testimony of James Allen, CEO, President and Member, Board of Managers of Seminole HR Holdings, LLC and HR Atlantic City, LLC (transcript pages 14-65); and Brad Buchanan, Executive VP & Chief Financial Officer of Seminole HR Holdings, LLC and HR Atlantic City, LLC (transcript pages 66-78).

A recess was taken and the Commission reconvened at 11:45 a.m.

The Commission considered the petition, written submissions, exhibits and oral arguments presented, and issued the following rulings:

By a vote of 3-0, approved the petition and issued the following rulings:

- a) Found the following natural person qualifiers, but for residence, qualified for approval as casino key employees, as identified in the Director of the Division of Gaming Enforcement Order PRN 0291406 dated February 6, 2014: James F. Allen, Brad Buchanan, Hamish Dodds, Connie Whidden, James Shore, Michael D. Rumoblz, Roberts L. Gips, Henry W. Hornbustel, Agnes Billie-Motlow and Carla Gopher
- b) HR Atlantic City, LLC, Seminole Hard Rock Entertainment, Inc., SHRE/SHRI, LLC and Seminole HR Holdings, LLC are each qualified, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-85.1; and
- c) Granted HR Atlantic City, LLC a Statement of Compliance, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 5:12-85.1.

all subject to the conditions and to the extent set forth in the resolution (PRN 0371402) (Ruling number 15-01-29; transcript pages 1-89)
