MINUTES - PUBLIC MEETING NO. 26-06-10
June 10, 2026 - 10:30 p.m.

New Jersey Casino Control Commission
Joseph P. Lordi Public Meeting Room - First Floor

In furtherance of Governor Philip D. Murphy's Executive Order 103 (2020), the Casino Control Commission's meeting was held via remote technology, as well as in person. The public listened telephonically by calling the telephone number and access number provided on the Commission's website, and public comments were accepted via e-mail.

Subsequent to the reading of a statement of compliance with the notice requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act, the Commission considered and took formal action on the following matters:

1. By a vote of 3-0, ratified the minutes of May 13, 2026 (transcript pages 8-9).
2. By a vote of 3-0, granted the initial applications of Alicia M. Hall, Abdur R. Johnson-Molley (*a/k/a* Abdur-Rahim Johnson-Molley, Abdur R. Johnson), , Brian J. Roberts (*a/k/a* Brian J. Gayle), Saudlita S. Roberts and Maria S. Santos (*a/k/a* Maria S. Garcia, Maria S. Garcia-Colon, Maria S. Minor), for casino key employee licenses (transcript pages 9-10); and

By a vote of 3-0, remanded the initial application of Christopher M. Gehricke, for a casino key employee license and qualification to a hearing (transcript page 10-12).

3. By a vote of 3-0, granted the resubmitted applications of David S. Breslin, Madonna M. Callahan (*a/k/a* Madonna M. Noecker), Lakeisha M. Finch, Karen M. Hober (*a/k/a* Karen T. Moy), Kenneth C. Klotz, Dijana Kukavica-Vickovic (*a/k/a* Dijana Vickovic), Stephannie Lopez, Nanette Negron, Mary E. O'Brien (*a/k/a* Mary E. Mick), Lewis M. Ostrander, II, Christa C. Schulte, Carrie A. Velez (*a/k/a* Carrie A. Phister) and Joseph G. Yost, IV, for casino key employee licenses. (Exhibit EL-1*; transcript pages 12-14).
4. Temporary casino key employee licenses were issued between May 1, 2026 and May 31, 2026, pursuant to Delegation of Authority Resolution Number 26-02-11-16-D to the following applicants: Brandon V. Miral, Lisa G. Pettus, Makiyah A. Pollitt and Marlene Vargas-Toledo (Exhibit EL-3*; transcript pages 14-16).
5. By a vote of 3-0, granted the requested relief and inactivated the casino key employee licenses held by Christopher A. Gumiel, Gerald Schafer and Alexander Sutocky, 2nd (Ruling numbers 26-06-10-05-A, 26-06-10-05-B, 26-06-10-05-C; transcript pages 16-17).
6. By a vote of 3-0, found that Michael M. Clement, Jacqueline S. Grace-Pope (*a/k/a* Jacqueline S. Grace), Michael J. Harwell and Nibin Philip, casino key employee licenses lapsed, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 19:41A-6.1 (f) of the regulations. (Ruling numbers 26-06-10-06-A, 26-06-10-06-B, 26-06-10-06-C, 26-06-10-06-D; transcript pages 17-19).
7. By a vote of 3-0, granted the resubmission application of Susan Nicodemus, for a casino key employee license (DKT 25-0111-CR) (Ruling number 26-06-10-07; transcript pages 19-22).
8. Considered the resubmission application of Rebecca Butler-Nesbitt, for a casino key employee license and issued the following ruling:

By a vote of 3-0, approved the stipulation of settlement between the Division of Gaming Enforcement and Applicant; and granted the resubmission application of Rebecca Butler-Nesbitt, for a casino key employee license, subject to compliance with the terms and conditions as provided for in the stipulation (DKT 25-0212-CR) (Ruling number 26-06-10-08; transcript pages 22-25).

9. By a vote of 2-1 (Vice Chair Mollineaux dissented), adopted the draft resolution and issued a plenary casino key employee license to Rinju S. Mathew, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-89; and found Mr. Mathew qualified to serve as Director of I-Gaming for Caesars Interactive Entertainment New Jersey, LLC, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1, N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.6 and N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.7. Further, granted the petitioners' request to waive the residency requirement, as provided for in N.J.S.A. 5:12-89 (26-06-10-09; transcript pages 25-26).
10. By a vote of 3-0, adopted the draft resolution and issued a plenary casino key employee license to Allison Smith-Mitchell, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-89b; and found Allison Smith-Mitchell qualified to serve as Vice President of Human Resources for Marina District Development Company LLC (*d/b/a* Borgata Hotel Casino & Spa), in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1 and N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.6 (Ruling number 26-06-10-10; transcript pages 56-60).
11. By a vote of 3-0, adopted the draft resolution and found Ayesha K. Molino, plenary qualified to serve as Chief Operating Officer for MGM Resorts International, in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1 and N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.7 (Ruling Number 26-06-10-11; transcript pages 60-63).
12. By a vote of 3-0, adopted the draft resolution and found Brandon W. Dardeau, plenary qualified to serve as Regional President of Operations for MGM Resorts International, in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1 and N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.7 (Ruling Number 26-06-10-12; transcript pages 63-66).
13. By a vote of 3-0, adopted the draft resolution and issued a plenary casino key employee license to Alison Fogarty, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-89; and found Alison Fogarty qualified to serve as Vice President of Marketing for Marina District Development Company LLC (*d/b/a* Borgata Hotel Casino & Spa), in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1 and N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.6 (Ruling number 26-06-10-13; transcript pages 66-70).

In accordance with Resolution No. 25-12-10-03, the next closed session of the Commission shall be held on Wednesday, July 8, 2026 at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Offices (transcript page 70).

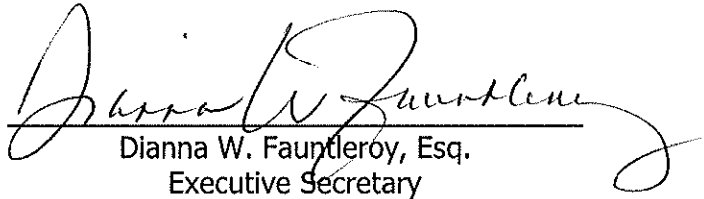
There being no members of the public to address the Commission, the meeting adjourned at 11:29 a.m.
