WHEREAS, MGA Gaming NJ, LLC (MGA) holds a casino service industry enterprise license issued by the Division of Gaming Enforcement (Division) pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-92a; and

WHEREAS, by PRN 1271402, filed with the Division on May 7, 2014, MGA seeks a ruling by the New Jersey Casino Control Commission (Commission) granting a waiver of the residency requirement in N.J.S.A. 5:12-89b(4) for Thomas P. Burke, President of MGA; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Burke is the holder of a valid casino key employee licensee (609-11) and is an applicant for resubmission pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-94h(1); and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 5:12-89b(4) requires the holder of a key license to be a resident of the State of New Jersey, provided, however, that the Commission may grant a waiver of such requirement for an applicant whose position will require him to be employed outside the State; and

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WHEREAS, by Letter Reports dated November 5, 2013, and May 9, 2014, the Division indicated that Mr. Burke does not meet the residency requirement in section 89b(4) but recommends that the Commission find that he meets the standards for waiver thereof;

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the matter at its public meeting on May 14, 2014;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that the request of MGA Gaming NJ, LLC for a waiver of the residency requirement in N.J.S.A. 5:12-89b(4) for Thomas P. Burke, President of MGA is hereby GRANTED based upon the findings and rulings herein;

FINDINGS and RULINGS

Based upon consideration of the entire record of these proceedings, the Commission issues the following rulings and makes the following findings:

- (a) Thomas P. Burke is required to hold a casino key employee license by virtue of his position as President of MGA and is the holder of a valid casino key employee license (609-11);
- (b) Mr. Burke's position requires him to be employed outside the State and as such, he meets the standard for waiver of the residency requirement pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-89b(4); and



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(c) Mr. Burke has demonstrated that he continues to meet the requirements of section 89 of the Act in accordance with N.J.S.A. 5:12-94h.
