- 4. The Applicants have established by clear and convincing evidence that that they possess the financial stability, integrity and responsibility and the good character, honesty and integrity required by *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-84, 85.1 and 89; and
- 6. The Applicants, in view of the foregoing and the entire record of the proceeding, are each qualified as a holding company of Harrah's AC.
