WHEREAS, MGM Resorts International (MGM), a holding company of casino licensee Marina District Development Company, LLC d/b/a Borgata Hotel Casino & Spa (MDDC or Borgata) and MGM Growth Properties LLC (MGP) (collectively Petitioners) filed a joint petition on June 15, 2016, which was amended on June 29, 2016, seeking a ruling from the New Jersey Casino Control Commission (Commission) 1) approving a sublease from MGM Lessee, LLC (MGM Lessee) to Borgata (Operating Sublease) pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-82c, 2) approving a Master Lease, as amended by a First Amendment to Master Lease (collectively, Amended Master Lease) between MGM Lessee and MGP Lessor, LLC (MGP Lessor) as it relates to Borgata pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-82c, 3) finding MGM Lessee qualified as an entity qualifier and 4) delegating to the Chairman the authority to approve amendments to the Amended Master Lease as they relate to Borgata and amendments to the Operating Sublease to the extent any such amendment does not relate to the "buy-out," "joint and several liability" or

termination provisions required by  $\underline{N.J.S.A.}$  5:12-82c(5) and (10) and  $\underline{N.J.S.A.}$  5:12-104b; and

#### FINDINGS and RULINGS

Based upon consideration of the entire record of these proceedings, the Commission issues the followings rulings and makes the following findings:

- 1. The Master Lease, First Amendment to Master Lease and Operating Sublease are hereby approved.
  - 2. MGM Lessee is qualified as an entity qualifier.

#### CONDITIONS

Based upon the entire record of the proceedings, the rulings set forth herein are subject to the following conditions:

- 1. MGP Lessor and MGM Lessee shall provide the Division with final copies of the First Amendment to Master Lease and the Operating Sublease with MDDC within five (5) days of execution.
- 2. MGP Lessor and MGM Lessee shall immediately notify the Division if either party seeks termination of the Master Lease.
- 3. MGM Lessee and MDDC shall immediately notify the Division if either party seeks termination of the Operating Sublease.
- 4. Amendments to the Amended Master Lease as they relate to Borgata and amendments to the Operating Sublease are subject to approval by the Commission upon the filing of a petition by MGM and MGP with the Division and an opportunity for the Division to submit a report regarding such changes. The Commission hereby delegates authority to the Chairman to make a determination on any such amendment petition, following receipt of a responsive Division report, if a proposed amendment does not relate to the buy-out, joint and several liability or termination provisions required by N.J.S.A. 5:12-82c(5) and (10) and -104b, respectively, which matters must be determined by the full Commission.
- 5. The requirements set forth in the previously mentioned Conditions shall not be modified or eliminated except with the approval of the Division Director or his designee, with notice of such approval directed to the Chairman of the Commission.
