WHEREAS, this matter having been brought before the New Jersey Casino Control Commission (Commission) by the petition of casino licensee HR Atlantic City, LLC (HRAC/Petitioner) for the issuance of a temporary casino key employee license and waiver of residency, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-89(b)(4) and -89(e) and N.J.A.C. 19:41A-5.3(d), to Elizabeth Louise Price, and for permission for Ms. Price to serve as the Chief Compliance Officer for HRAC and Seminole HR Holdings, LLC (Holdings) for a nine-month period pending her plenary licensure and qualification, in accordance with the conditions contained in N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1c and N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.7; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Price filed a Personal History Disclosure Form 3 (PHD-3) with the Division of Gaming Enforcement (Division) and will file a PHD-MJ and NJ Supplement by July 26, 2018 as required by N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.7(c); and

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2018 the Division interposed no objection to the Commission granting the requested relief; and

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the entire record of the matter at its public meeting of July 11, 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that Elizabeth Louise Price, upon perfection of her casino key employee license application, is hereby granted a waiver of residency and temporary casino key employee license pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-89(b)(4) and -89(e) and N.J.A.C. 19:41A-5.3(d), and is temporarily qualified and authorized to assume the duties and exercise the powers of Chief Compliance Officer for HRAC and Holdings, subject to the conditions contained in N.J.S.A. 5:12-89 and N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.7.
