WHEREAS, James R. Hurley was appointed to the New Jersey Casino Control Commission by Governor Thomas Kean as a Member in January 1990. He was reappointed by Governor James Florio in 1992 and by Governor Christine Todd Whitman in 1997; and

WHEREAS, in 1994, Governor Whitman appointed James R. Hurley as the Commission's representative to the Casino Reinvestment Development Authority (CRDA), where he chaired the Atlantic City Economic Development Committee and was a member of both the Personnel and Administration Committee and the South Jersey Project Review Committee; and

WHEREAS, on October 29, 1998, James R. Hurley was elevated to the position of chairman, becoming the fifth chairman of the New Jersey Casino Control Commission; and

WHEREAS, Chairman Hurley served the Commission and the people of the State of New Jersey with great distinction from 2009 until his retirement from public office in 2002; and

WHEREAS, Chairman Hurley demonstrated the highest level of personal integrity, scholarship and dedication in fulfilling his duties and responsibilities as a Member and Chairman of the Commission thereby enhancing the public trust and confidence in the regulation of casino gaming in New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, his acute insight, attention to detail and perceptive analysis of complex issues aided immeasurably in the Commission decision-making process during a crucial period in the development of casino gaming in Atlantic City and beyond; and

WHEREAS, Chairman Hurley exhibited honesty, dignity and compassion in discharging his duties and ensuring that all entities and individuals having matters before the Commission were treated fairly and equitably; and

WHEREAS, Chairman Hurley was a tenacious advocate and tireless watchdog in his efforts to ensure the ongoing integrity of the casino regulatory process and relentless in his efforts to revitalize Atlantic City and restore it as a convention and entertainment center and destination resort; and

WHEREAS, his passion, professionalism and wisdom earned him the praise, respect and admiration of his colleagues and the entire casino gaming community; and

WHEREAS, Chairman Hurley passed away on June 17, 2023 at the age of 91; and

WHEREAS, Chairman Hurley will be remembered for his lifetime of public service and leadership and will be deeply missed by his family, friends, former colleagues and the people of the State of New Jersey;
