RESOLUTION OF THE NEW JERSEY CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION CONCERNING AN AMENDED AND RESTATED STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT AND THE CONTINUED INITIAL CASINO KEY EMPLOYEE LICENSURE AND PLENARY QUALIFICATION OF JESSICA LYNN SMITH TO SERVE AS VICE PRESIDENT FACILITIES FOR MARINA DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, LLC d/b/a BORGATA HOTEL CASINO & SPA

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2022, the New Jersey Casino Control Commission ("Commission") granted temporary qualification to Jessica Lynn Smith to assume the duties and exercise the powers of Vice President Facilities for casino licensee, Marina District Development Company, LLC d/b/a Borgata Hotel Casino & Spa ("Borgata"), for a nine-month period in accordance with the conditions contained in *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-85.1 and *N.J.A.C.* 13:69C-2.6 and issued Jessica Lynn Smith a temporary casino key employee license pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-89e and *N.J.A.C.* 19:41A-5.3 (Commission Resolution No. 22-06-08-15); and

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2023 the Commission considered and approved a Stipulation of Settlement between the Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division") and Jessica Lynn Smith and issued her a casino key employee license (#10660-11) and found her qualified to serve as Vice President of Facilities for Borgata subject to compliance with the terms and conditions of the Stipulation of Settlement (Commission Resolution No. 23-03-08-14); and

WHEREAS, the Division filed a Supplemental Letter Report dated October 18, 2023 which incorporated an amended and restated Stipulation of Settlement ("Restated Stipulation") dated and signed October 13, 2023, between Jessica L. Smith, as licensee, and Tracy E. Richardson, Deputy Attorney General on behalf of the Division, recommending the approval of the Restated Stipulation and not objecting to the continued casino key employee licensure and qualification of Jessica Lynn Smith to continue to serve as Vice President Facilities for Borgata subject to the terms and conditions of the Restated Stipulation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the entire record of the proceedings at its public meeting of November 15, 2023, including the consent of Jessica Lynn Smith to the Commission approval and adoption of the Restated Stipulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that the Restated Stipulation between the Division and Jessica Lynn Smith, which is incorporated herein by reference, is **APPROVED**.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED by the Commission that Jessica Lynn Smith's casino key employee license remains in good standing pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-89 and she remains qualified to serve as Vice President Facilities for Borgata in accordance with, and subject to the conditions contained in

N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1 and *N.J.A.C.* 13:69C-2.6, and further subject to her compliance with the terms of the Restated Stipulation.
