RESOLUTION OF THE NEW JERSEY CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION CONCERNING THE PLENARY QUALIFICATION OF DIGITAL HOLDCO, LLC AS A NEW HOLDING COMPANY OF CAESARS INTERACTIVE ENTERTAINMENT NEW JERSEY, LLC AND FOR VARIOUS OTHER RULINGS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH PURSUANT TO *N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1*

WHEREAS, Internet Gaming Affiliate casino licensee Caesars Interactive Entertainment New Jersey, LLC (“CIENJ”) and its qualified parent holding company, Caesars Entertainment, Inc. (“CEI”) having filed a Joint Petition (PRN 1232401) dated May 1, 2024 seeking a ruling from the New Jersey Casino Control Commission (“Commission”) pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq.* (“the Act”) finding Digital Holdco, LLC (“Digital HoldCo”) qualified as a new holding/intermediary company of casino licensee, CIENJ, and finding that the natural person qualifiers of Digital HoldCo remain qualified; and

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2013 the Commission granted casino licensure to CIENJ as an Internet gaming affiliate pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 5:12-82b(5)* (*see*, Commission Resolution No. 13-11-20-15); and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2020, the Commission approved the Merger Agreement between Eldorado Resorts Inc. and CEI and determined that the merged entity, CEI, its qualifying entities, and its natural person qualifiers, including, among others, Anthony Carano, Edmund Quatmann, Thomas Reeg



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and Bret Yunker continued to meet the requirements for licensure as set forth in *N.J.S.A. 5:12-84* and *-85* (see, Commission Order No. 20-07-15-14); and

WHEREAS, on or about September 30, 2020 CEI entered into an agreement for the acquisition of William Hill PLC, pursuant to which William Hill US Holdco (“WH US”) would become an intermediary holding company of CIENJ; and

WHEREAS, on or about April 22, 2021, CEI acquired WH US, thereafter merging Caesars Interactive Entertainment, Inc. (“CIE”), a qualified holding company of CIENJ, into WH US, with CIENJ thereafter becoming a wholly owned subsidiary of WH US; and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2022, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 5:12-87.1*, the Division reviewed the casino license of CIENJ, and determined that its entity qualifiers and natural person qualifiers continued to meet the requirements for licensure as set forth in *N.J.S.A. 5:12-84* and *-85*; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2023, the Commission granted plenary qualification to WH US as a new holding company of casino licensee CIENJ, and granted plenary qualification to its natural person qualifier, Eric Hession as President of “Caesars Digital”, and found additional natural person qualifiers, including, Anthony Carano, Edmund Quatmann, Thomas Reeg and Bret Yunker,



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having been previously found qualified, remained qualified (see, Commission Resolution No. 23-05-17-21); and

WHEREAS, the Division having designated the following officers as natural person qualifiers of Digital HoldCo pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1* in connection with its current Petition (PRN 1232401) for qualification: Anthony Carano as President and Chief Operating Officer (“COO”) of CEI; Eric Hession as President, Caesars Digital; Edmund Quatmann as Executive Vice President, Chief Legal Officer and Secretary of CEI; Thomas Reeg as Chief Executive Officer (“CEO”) of CEI and Bret Yunker, CFO of CEI; and

WHEREAS, Anthony Carano, Eric Hession, Edmund Quatmann, Thomas Reeg, and Bret Yunker having been previously found qualified by the Commission, hereby remain qualified; and

WHEREAS, the Division filed a Letter Report dated October 3, 2024, wherein it recommended that the Commission grant the relief requested; and

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the entire record in this matter, together with the presentations of counsel, at its public meeting of November 13, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commission that based upon the report of the Division and all other evidence presented to the Commission at the public meeting of November 13, 2024, Petitioners’ request to



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qualify Digital HoldCo, and its natural person qualifiers is hereby **GRANTED** based upon the findings and rulings specified herein.

FINDINGS and RULINGS

Based upon consideration of the entire record of these proceedings, the Commission enters the following findings and rulings:

1. Digital HoldCo and its natural person qualifiers hereto have complied with all requirements regarding the submission of information necessary to the Commission and the Division to evaluate PRN 1232401;
2. The individuals whose qualification need to be established for purposes of PRN 1232401 are: Anthony Carano, Eric Hession, Edmund Quatmann, Thomas Reeg and Bret Yunker, each of whom has been previously found qualified by the Commission and remain qualified pursuant to applicable provisions of the Act;
3. Digital HoldCo has established compliance with *N.J.S.A. 5:12-82d(7),(8) and (10) and 85b*;
4. Digital HoldCo has established by clear and convincing evidence that it possesses the financial stability, integrity and responsibility and good character, honesty and integrity required by *N.J.S.A. 5:12-84 and 85.1*; and




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
