RESOLUTION OF THE NEW JERSEY CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION
CONCERNING THE PLENARY QUALIFICATION OF AMEET L. PATEL TO SERVE

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2025, the New Jersey Casino Control Commission ("Commission") granted the Petition (PRN 3252502) of casino licensee, Premier Entertainment AC, LLC ("Premier") d/b/a Bally's Atlantic City ("Bally's AC"), and its qualified holding company, Bally's Corporation ("Bally's"), to have Ameet L.
