WHEREAS, casino licensee Premier Entertainment AC, LLC ("Premier") d/b/a Bally's Atlantic City and its qualified parent holding company, Bally's Corporation ("Bally's") filed a Joint Petition (PRN 0342601) dated February 3, 2026, seeking a ruling from the New Jersey Casino Control Commission ("Commission") pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq. (the "Act"), in connection with an amended and restated commitment letter dated December 8, 2025, between Bally's and Ares Management LLC ("Ares"), et al. ("Commitment Letter"), pursuant to which Ares committed to provide increased financing commitments from the initial commitment letter entered in July 2025; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the Commitment Letter, the Director of the Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division"), pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1c (5), designated Ares as a financial source qualifier of Premier pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1e and N.J.A.C. 13:69C-5B.1; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Commitment Letter, through PRN 0292605, dated January 29, 2026, Premier undertook material debt transaction approval from the Division pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:69C-4.3; and

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WHEREAS, by Order PRN 0292605 dated July 29, 2026, the Division approved the material debt transaction and determined that Premier would remain financially stable following completion of the Commitment Letter in accordance with the Act, subject to conditions; and

WHEREAS, by Letter Report dated July 30, 2026, the Division recommended that the Commission find Ares qualified as a financial source of Premier; and

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the entire record in this matter at its public meeting of August 12, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commission that Petitioners' request to qualify Ares as a financial source in connection with its entry into a Commitment Letter is hereby **GRANTED** based upon the Findings and Rulings specified herein.

FINDINGS and RULINGS

Based upon consideration of the entire record of these proceedings, the Commission enters the following findings and rulings:

1. Ares has complied with all requirements pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:69C-5B.1 regarding the submission of information necessary for the Commission and the Division to evaluate PRN 0342601.



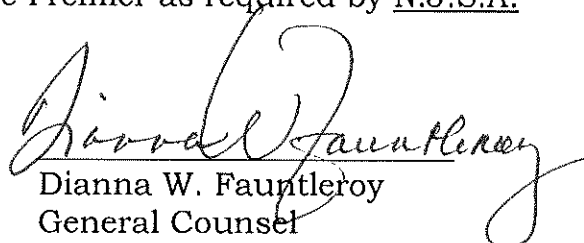

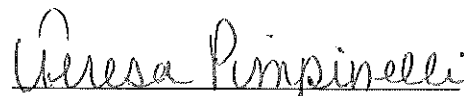

RESOLUTION OF THE NEW JERSEY CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION CONCERNING THE PETITION OF BOARDWALK REGENCY, LLC D/B/A CAESARS ATLANTIC CITY FOR THE TEMPORARY NEW JERSEY CASINO KEY EMPLOYEE LICENSURE OF MICHAEL PISTONE PURSUANT TO *N.J.S.A. 5:12-89E* AND REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR MICHAEL PISTONE TO ASSUME THE DUTIES AND EXERCISE THE POWERS OF VICE PRESIDENT OF CASINO MARKETING FOR BOARDWALK REGENCY, LLC PURSUANT TO *N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.6* (PRN 2182601)

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WHEREAS, by response dated August 7, 2026, the Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division") interposed no objection to the relief requested in the Petition and to the Commission issuing a temporary casino key employee license to Michael Pistone and permitting him to assume the duties and exercise the powers of Vice President of Casino Marketing for Caesars AC prior to plenary qualification; and

WHEREAS, the Division also does not object to Commission consideration of PRN 2182601 prior to the expiration of the period specified in *N.J.S.A. 5:12-89e(2)*; and

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the entire record of the proceedings at its public meeting of August 12, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that Michael Pistone be issued a temporary casino key employee license pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 5:12-89e* pending initial casino key employee licensure; and

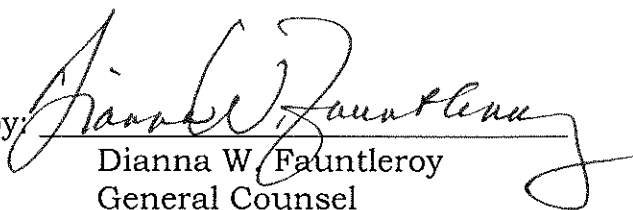

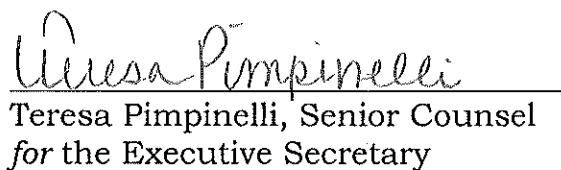
