For over a decade, the Rutgers Youth Success Program has helped justice-impacted young people in Camden NJ overcome barriers to sustainable employment through work-readiness training, professional mentorship, and diverse partnerships across New Jersey.

Funded by the NJ Department of Labor, the JOBS program is designed to support justice-impacted young adults from South Jersey in finding sustainable career-oriented jobs, learning critical work skills, and ultimately gaining employment.

Housed at Rutgers CAIT, our focus is on jobs in the transportation industry. Our graduates have found career paths as auto mechanics, carpenters, public transit professionals, and more.

We partner with organizations statewide, such as the Transformative Justice Initiative, to provide a range of services including case management, college & interview prep, and job-readiness training.
