RESOLUTION OF THE NEW JERSEY CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION
HONORING THE MEMORY OF THE HONORABLE EILEEN R. PETERSEN, FIRST




WHEREAS, her passion, professionalism, tenacity and wisdom earned her the praise, respect and admiration of her colleagues and the entire casino gaming community;


