

## SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND MUTUAL RELEASE

THIS SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND MUTUAL RELEASE ("Settlement Agreement") is entered into this 20th day of December, 2016 ("Effective Date") by and between Charles Haddad MD ("Dr. Haddad") and the STATE OF NEW JERSEY, OFFICE OF THE STATE COMPTROLLER, MEDICAID FRAUD DIVISION ("MFD"). Dr. Haddad and MFD are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties" and each individually as a "Party."

WHEREAS, MFD reviewed the Medicaid billing of Dr. Haddad and found that between July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2015 for Fee-for-Service claims and July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2015 for Medicaid Managed Care claims, Dr. Haddad submitted claims for American Medical Association (AMA) Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) code 99214 for services provided to Medicaid patients which resulted in an overpayment of \$112,677.00. Dr. Haddad did not provide documentation to support the level of code, CPT 99214, that was billed.

WHEREAS, Dr. Haddad was given credit for performing the service that would have been reimbursable at a lower payment for CPT 99213;

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed that Dr. Haddad should be given credit in the amount of \$19,677.00, which reduced the overpayment to \$93,000.00;

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amicably resolve all disputes between them giving rise to the recovery and have reached a mutually acceptable resolution of the controversies that exist between them;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, as well as for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree to settle their dispute on the following terms:

(1) Dr. Haddad agrees to pay to MFD the sum of ninety-three thousand dollars (\$93,000.00) upon execution of the agreement.

(2) Payment shall be by certified check, bank check, or attorney trust check made payable to "Treasurer, State of New Jersey," and shall be mailed or delivered as follows:

Dr. Haddad will include "Charles Haddad MD [REDACTED]" in the memo line so that the payment is properly credited.

(3) The parties agree that this Settlement Agreement is intended to be a final resolution of all issues arising out of the claims at issue in this matter, and is intended by each party to release the other party and its representatives from liability arising out of the claims at issue in this matter, unless MFD is mandated to act by federal or State law; or mandated by order or judgment of a court or administrative agency (other than MFD).

(4) Nothing in this Settlement Agreement waives the rights of any other State or federal agency, including, among others, the New Jersey Division of Criminal Justice, from continuing with a pending or beginning a future civil or criminal investigation or other action for alleged conduct concerning Dr. Haddad or from taking any action for such conduct. Nothing in this Settlement Agreement waives the rights of MFD to conduct an audit or investigation of future years for the improper submission of any claims or conduct not specifically covered by this agreement, and to take any action civilly or criminally for such conduct.

(5) Subject to the express terms of this Settlement Agreement as provided for in paragraphs 1-4 above, by the signatures set forth below, the authorization of which is hereby affirmed, Dr. Haddad and MFD agree to the following Release: in consideration of the provision hereof including this release, each party agrees to release the other party and its representatives from liability, obligations and damages arising out of the recovery.

(6) Nothing herein shall constitute an admission, concession or finding of wrongdoing by any party.

(7) This Settlement Agreement shall be construed, enforced and governed by the laws of the State of New Jersey.

(8) This Settlement Agreement may be executed in Counterparts.

(9) This Settlement Agreement is effective upon the last date it is executed by the parties hereto.

(10) This Settlement Agreement sets forth the entire agreement between and among the parties hereto with respect to the claims described herein and supersedes any other written or oral understandings. This Settlement Agreement does not reflect any other terms or conditions or agreements between or among the parties with respect to any other matter.


