New Jersey, like the rest of the nation, experienced high mosquito activity in 2012, with the highest number of human cases on record—48 cases. The damage caused by Superstorm Sandy has created new places for mosquitoes to breed such as wet debris piles and depressions left by fallen trees.

## Selection Standards:

Requested items will be provided through open competitive bids solicited by the Department of Health Procurement team and will be subject to normal procurement regulations via vendors that meet applicable criteria.
