Overview:
Funding provided for dredging by NJDEP of Twilight Lake in Bay Head Borough in Ocean County. Project will remove 36,800 cubic yards of sand deposited in the lake by Hurricane Sandy. Funding is provided to remove threats to life, health and property as a result of natural disasters.
Federal Department of Origin:
United States Department of Agriculture/Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS)
Federal Requirements / Restrictions:
Project sponsor must be state government/agency or local government. 220 day time limit for projects. Project sponsor must provide between 10% to 25% of the project cost.
Selection Standards:
Applicant must demonstrate that an emergency watershed condition exists as a result of a natural disaster that has created a threat and risk to life, property and health.
Eligibility Standards:
Funding assistance is based on NRCS determination that the watershed impairment poses a threat to health, life or property. This assistance includes the removal of public health and safety threats and restoration of natural resources after disasters.
