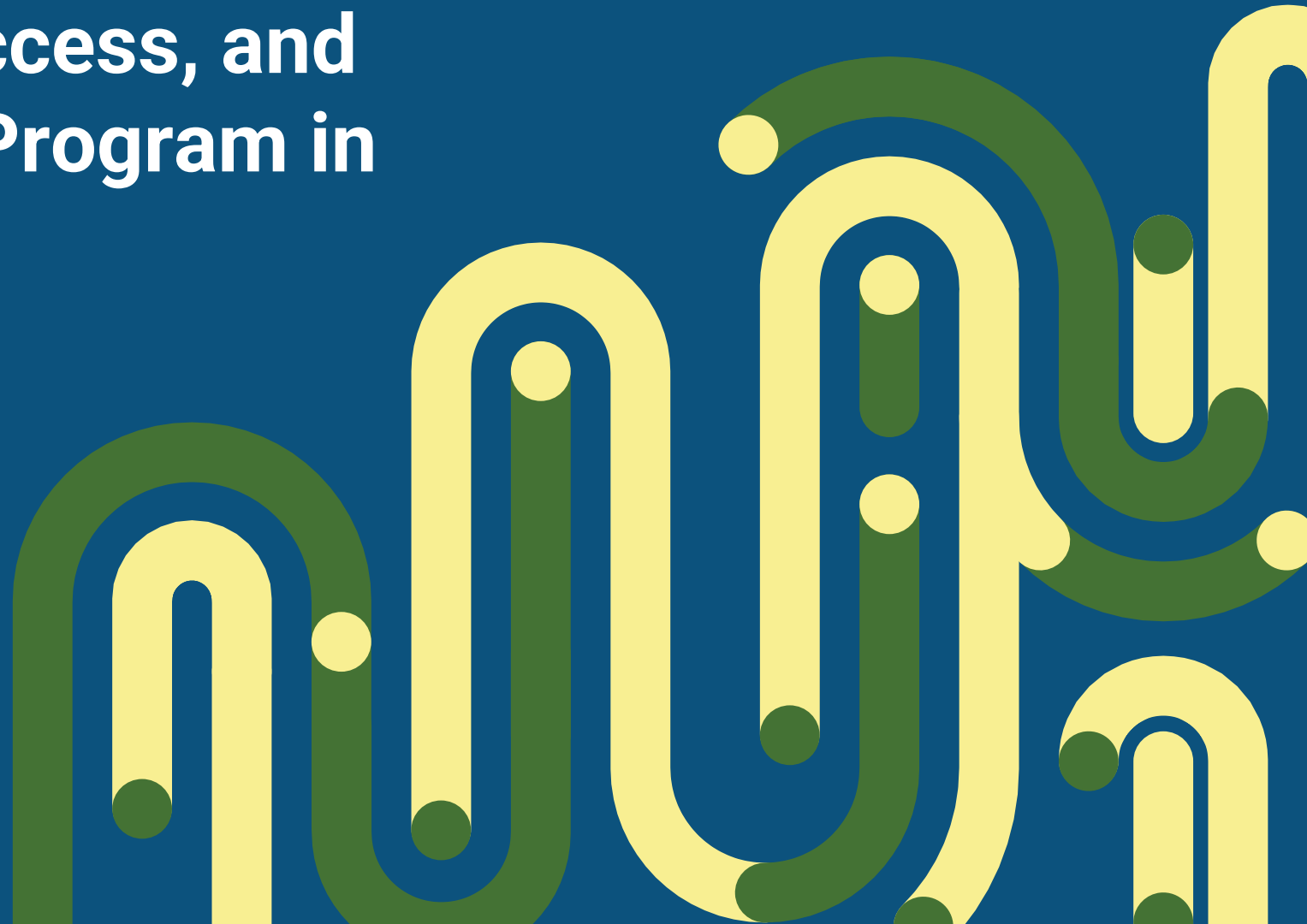

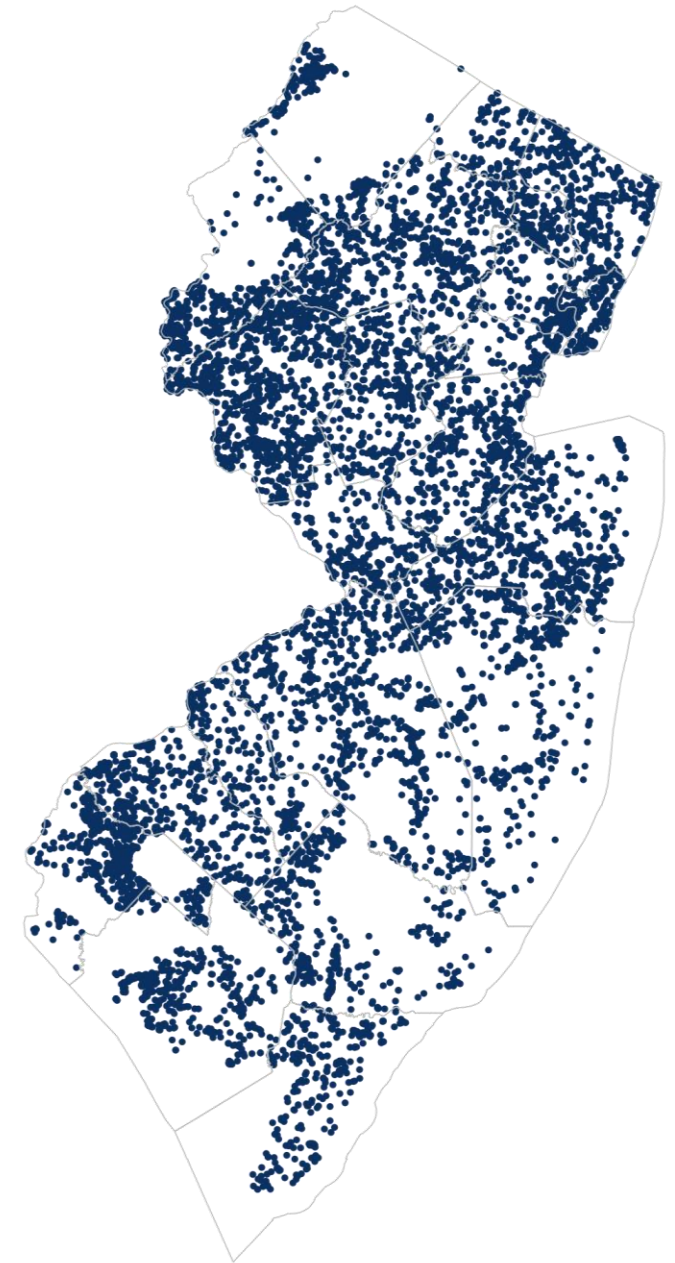

The dataset on the OBC website includes the list of BEAD-eligible Broadband Serviceable Locations (BSLs) with final classifications as unserved or underserved, as determined through the approved challenge process. The data reflects FCC Broadband Serviceable Location Fabric Version 4 (as of 12/31/2023), with applicable updates from Version 6 (as of 12/31/2024). Locations that are part of an existing enforceable commitment in New Jersey have been omitted from the dataset. This includes projects anticipated to be awarded through the New Jersey Broadband Infrastructure Deployment Equity (NJBIDE) Pilot Program.
2. The list of post-challenge Community Anchor Institutions (CAIs) on the OBC website has been revised pursuant to NTIA's Restructuring BEAD Policy Notice (06/062025).

Prequalification	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Prequalification window opened on 4/14. Prequalification applications may be submitted until 07/03/2025 at 5pm ET. This is the final extension of the prequalification windowEvaluation of Labor Standards, Workforce Readiness, and M/WBE Requirements (IP Vol 2, Requirements 11-13) in prequalification are removed per NTIA Policy Notice (PN)
Timeline	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Application window will open once NTIA has approved the Initial Proposal Correction Request and will close at 12 pm ET on 07/25/2025
Application preparation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">OBC will use counties as the geographic boundary for PABBsApplicants may propose to exclude BSLs that it determines are excessively high-cost locations from the project area or would otherwise make the project economically unviable for the technology being usedApplicants may request to have an application treated as a Priority Broadband Project regardless of the technology used; the applicant must provide documentation showing the proposed network meets the statutory requirements (e.g. speed, latency, scalability)
Scoring criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none">In deciding among competing applications covering the same general project areas, OBC will choose the option with the lowest cost based on minimal BEAD Program outlay; If an application to serve the same general project area proposes a project cost within 15% of the lowest-cost proposal received for that same general project area on a per BSL basis, OBC will evaluate such competing applications based on secondary criteria, giving greater weight to the Speed of Network and Other Technical Capabilities
Reporting requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Select reporting items are removed per PN (e.g. interconnection agreements, number of local hires)

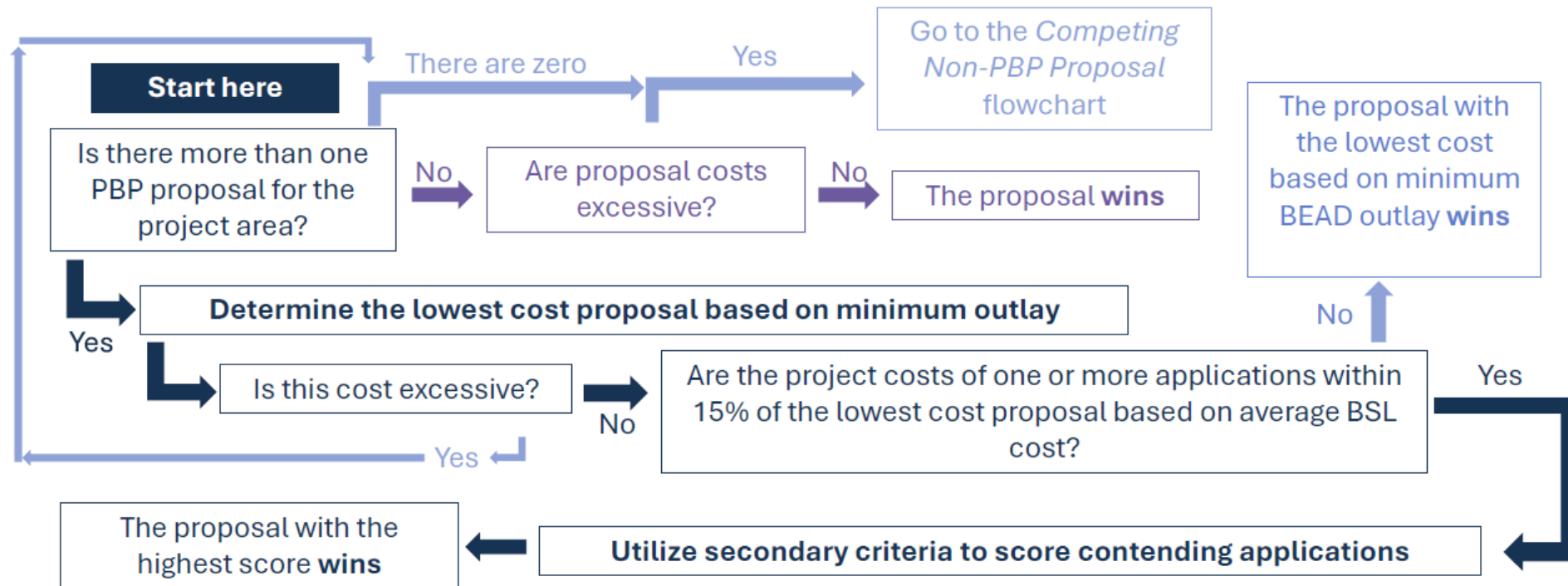

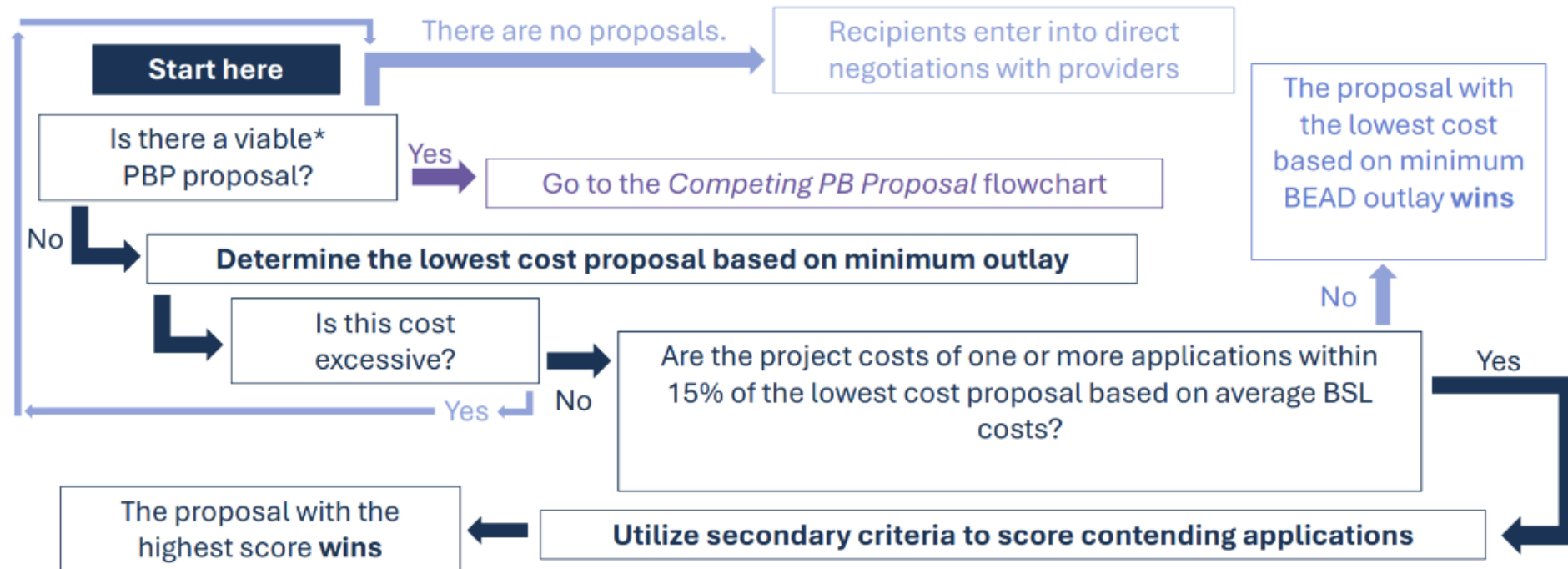
