- **Visual Identification:** To ensure clarity during interactions, the Department provides public-facing resources, including visual guides showing the device and its placement on both uniformed officers and plainclothes detectives.
- **Legal Compliance:** The Department remains in strict adherence to P.L. 2020, c. 129, ensuring that all officers wearing BWCs comply with notice requirements for any subject of a recording.

By integrating BWC technology into our operational framework, the Department enhances the safety of our staff and the individuals in our care, providing a verifiable record that supports our high standards of professional conduct and public trust.
