The northern region facilities are Adult Diagnostic Treatment Center (ADTC); East Jersey State Prison (EJSP); Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women (EMCF); Northern State Prison (NSP).</p>

<b>EDUCATION:</b> Graduation from an accredited college or university with an Associate's degree in Paralegal Studies or, an Associate Degree and a Certificate of Proficiency in Paralegal Studies.
