## INTRODUCTION and NOTES

### INTRODUCTION:

This report has been developed to provide information regarding population characteristics of incarcerated persons (IPs) in each correctional complex, major institution, and satellite housing unit under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Department of Corrections on January 1, 2026. The selected characteristics compiled in this report are Age, Base Offense at Admission, County of Commitment, Ethnicity, Mandatory Minimum Term, Race, and Total Term at Admission.

The Prison Complex includes the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center (ADTC)—a facility for adult males incarcerated for sexual offenses, Bayside State Prison, East Jersey State Prison, Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women (EMCF or Edna Mahan), Garden State Correctional Facility, Mid-State Correctional Facility, New Jersey State Prison, Northern State Prison, and South Woods State Prison.

### NOTES:

“Total Incarcerated Persons” count includes ECCF-TPV IPs housed in Essex County Jail, and are included in the Prison Complex data tables.

In the data tables, a separate subtotal is provided for Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women due to the interest in this unique population. The remainder of the Prison Complex is labeled “Male IPs.”

“ECCF-TPV” (or ECCF) includes IPs who are housed in the Essex County Jail with potential technical New Jersey State Parole Board (or NJSPB) violations, who are awaiting a hearing.

“RCRP, County Jails, CHR” include state-sentenced incarcerated persons housed in Residential Community Reintegrative Programs (RCRP), County Jails, and Central Medical Unit (or Capital Health Regional Medical Center, also referred to as CHR).

“Not Coded” are records for incarcerated persons in the correctional system for whom admission characteristics data had not been entered into the computerized information system as of January 1, 2026.

“Interstate Corrections Compacts (ICC)” are incarcerated persons with a New Jersey state sentence who were being held in the custody of another state on January 1, 2026. ICCs are not included in the Prison Complex data tables.

Out-of-state incarcerated persons listed under County of Commitment on page 25 are not New Jersey sentenced IPs but are being held in a New Jersey facility.

## HIGHLIGHTS

### POPULATION

- As of January 1, 2026, there are 12,471 incarcerated persons (IPs) under the custody of the New Jersey Department of Corrections (NJDOC).
- Of the 21 New Jersey counties, eleven (Atlantic, Bergen, Burlington, Camden, Essex, Hudson, Mercer, Middlesex, Monmouth, Passaic and Union) account for 81% of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC. Essex County is the highest contributor with 16% among all incarcerated persons. Camden County and Essex has the highest percentage of commitments at EMCF (13%).

### BY BASE OFFENSE

- Seventy-three percent (73%) of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC are committed for crimes against persons, or violent crimes, which include homicide, sexual assault, aggravated/simple assault, robbery, kidnapping, other sex offenses and other person offenses.
- Seventy-six percent (77%) of female IPs at Edna Mahan Correctional Facility (EMCF) are committed for crimes against persons, as compared with 76% of male IPs.
- Six percent (6%) of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC are committed for narcotics law violations, including possession, sale and distribution (4% are female IPs at EMCF, 21% are IPs within an RCRP, County Jail, or ECCF-TPV, 3% are ICCs, and 72% are Male IPs).

### BY TERM

- The median total term for all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC is 7 years. The median total term for female IPs at EMCF is 7 years; the median total term for male IPs is 8 years.
- Forty-six percent (46%) of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC are committed with total terms of 10 years or more.
- Forty-nine percent (49%) of male IPs have total terms of ten years or more; 42% of EMCF have a total term of ten years or more. Of the total IP population, seven percent (7%) are serving life sentences; 747 are serving life sentences with parole eligibility (708 male IPs, 23 ICCs, and

14 at EMCF), and 104 are serving life sentences without parole (98 male IPs, 2 at EMCF and 4 ICC's).

- Seventy-eight percent (78%) of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC have sentences that include mandatory minimum terms. Of the male IPs, 80% have mandatory minimum sentences; at EMCF 74% have mandatory minimum sentences.

### BY AGE

- Twenty-six percent (26%) of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC are 30 years of age or younger.
- The median age for IPs in all facilities is 38. The median age among females IPs at EMCF is 38 years; the median age among male IPs is 38.
- Among the male IPs, 26% are 30 years of age or younger; among the females at EMCF 24% are 30 years old or younger.
- Twenty-two percent (22%) of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC are over 50 years of age (3% are female IPs at EMCF, and 97% are male IPs).
- One percent (1%) of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC are 60 years of age (3 female IPs at EMCF, and 118 male IPs). One percent (0.8%) of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC are 62 years of age (3 female IPs at EMCF, and 92 male IPs).

### BY RACE and ETHNICITY

- Sixty-one percent (61%) of incarcerated persons in the NJDOC are Black, 25% White, and 1% Asian; 20% identify as Hispanic or Latino.
- Among male IPs 60% are Black, 25% are White, and 1% are Asian; 21% identify as Hispanic or Latino.
- Among female IPs at EMCF 50% are Black, 42% are White, 2% Asian, and 0.3% American Indian/ Alaskan Native; 17% identify as Hispanic or Latino.

## BASE OFFENSE

### INCARCERATED PERSONS IN NEW JERSEY CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS ON JANUARY 1, 2026, BY BASE OFFENSE

In these tabulations, the base offense is the most serious offense at the time of admission. These figures reflect base or controlling offenses at admission only and do not include any offenses in addition to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission. Additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the state correctional system are not included in these data. Most Serious Offense types by category highlighted below does not represent a complete enumeration of each violation type.

- Violent offenses include homicide, sexual assault, aggravated and simple assault, robbery, kidnapping, other sex offenses, and other person offenses (i.e. human trafficking, coercion, death by auto, and manslaughter). Violent offenses grouped as "Other Sex" include criminal sexual attempt, child pornography, endangering the welfare of a child, prostitution, and sex offender registration violations.
- Property offenses include burglary, arson, theft, forgery, embezzlement, fencing, and receiving/possessing stolen property.
- Public policy offenses include racketeering, gambling, corruption, perjury, resisting or eluding arrest, hindering apprehension, escape, juvenile and family-related offenses, and conspiracy.
- Weapons offenses include weapon possession and operation.
- Drug violations include distribution, manufacture, possession, and use of drugs.

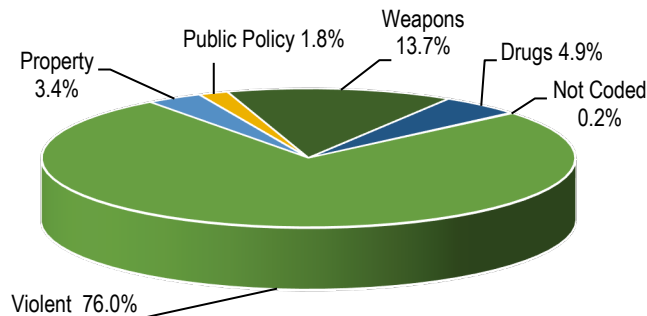

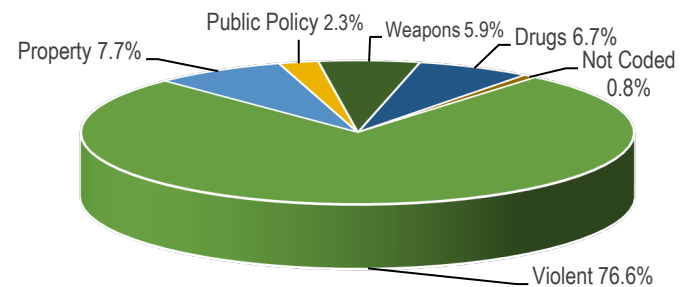

- Eight percent (7.78%) of female IPs at Edna Mahan were committed for property offenses.

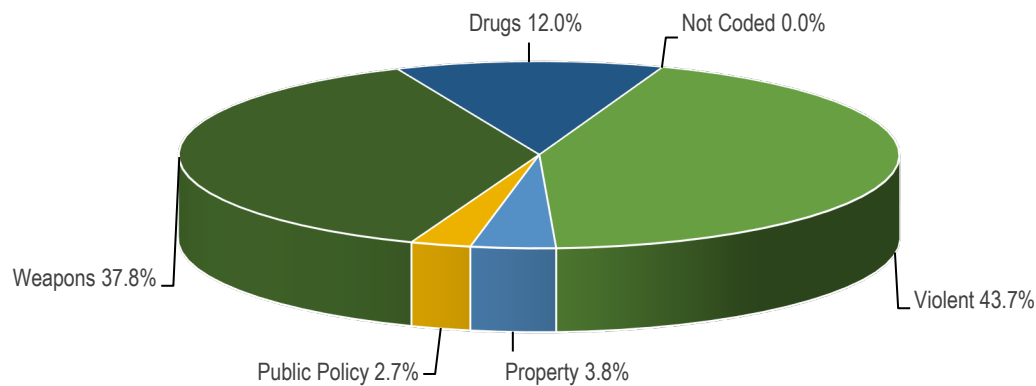

- Base offenses for incarcerated persons housed in County Jails, ECCF-TPV, RCRP, and CHR are less serious than male IPs overall (i.e. 43.7% vs. 76.0%, respectively).
- Thirty-eight percent (37.8%) of incarcerated persons housed in RCRP, County Jails, and CHR were committed for weapons offenses.



## MAXIMUM TERM AT ADMISSION

### INCARCERATED PERSONS IN NEW JERSEY CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS ON JANUARY 1, 2026, BY TOTAL TERM AT ADMISSION

Total term at admission is the total maximum term imposed for each incarcerated person at the time of commitment from the community or from parole. This includes the aggregate term for those admitted with multiple sentences. Additional sentences received following initial admission are not reflected or included in the data.

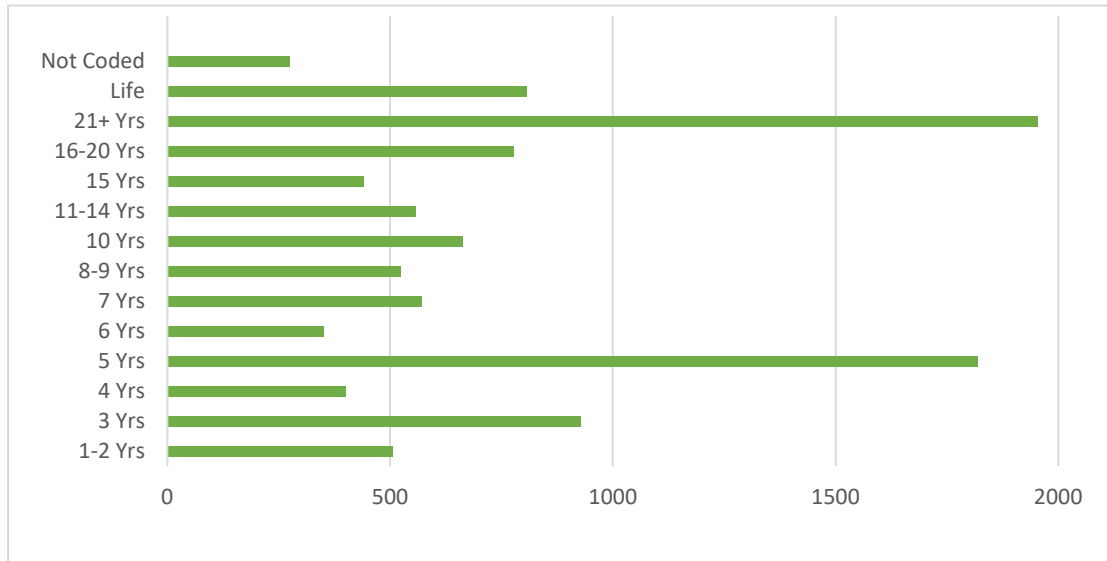

- The median term for all incarcerated persons is 7 years.
- Thirty-eight percent (38%) of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC are serving terms of 1-5 years.
- Fourteen percent (14%) of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC are serving terms of 6-9 years.
- Forty-six percent (46%) of all incarcerated persons in the NJDOC are serving terms of 10 years or more, which includes 747 IPs serving life with parole and 104 serving life without parole sentences.



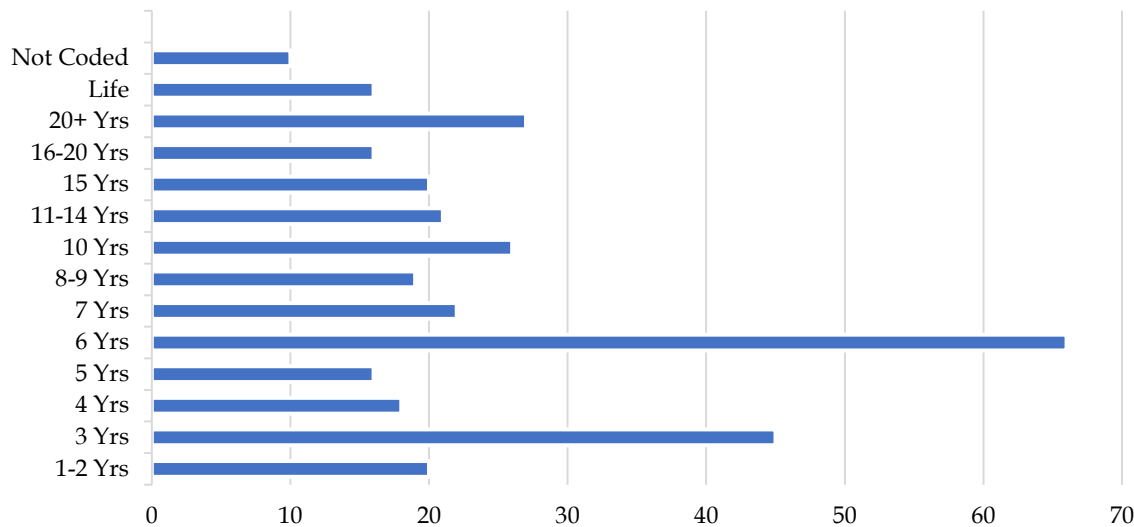
# MAXIMUM TERM AT ADMISSION

## MALE IPs



- The median term for male IPs is 8.5 years.
- Thirty-five percent (35%) of all male IPs are serving sentences of 5 years or less.
- Thirty-eight percent (38%) of all male IPs are serving sentences of 15 years or more, with 708 serving Life With Parole and 98 serving Life Without Parole.

## EDNA MAHAN



- The median term for IPs at Edna Mahan is 7 years.
- Thirty-eight percent (38%) of the IPs at Edna Mahan are serving sentences of 5 years or less.
- Thirty-one percent (31%) of the IPs at Edna Mahan are serving sentences of 15 years or more, with 14 serving Life With Parole and 2 serving Life Without Parole.

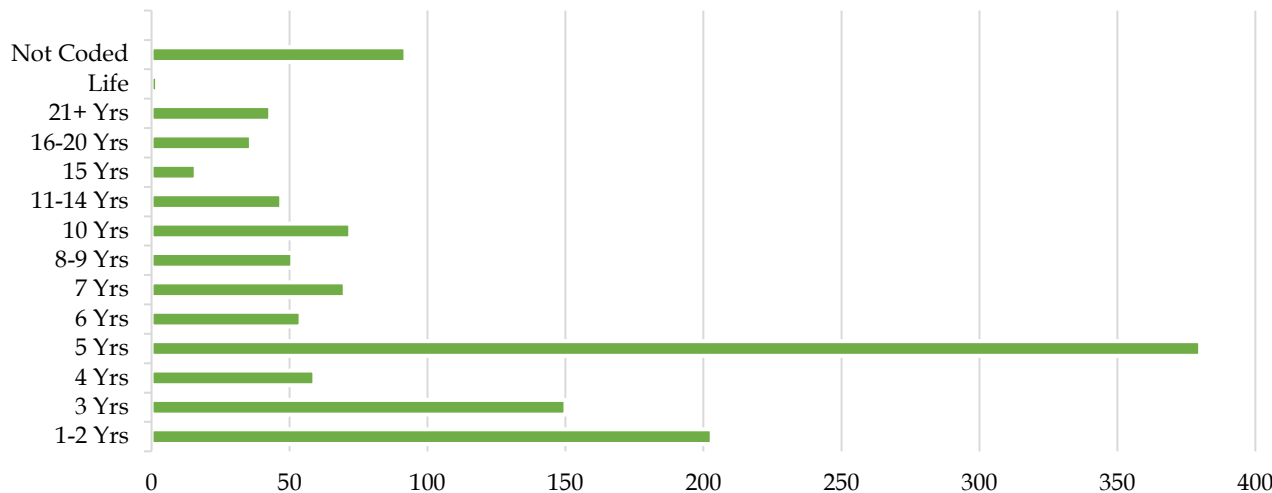

- The median term for IPs housed in RCRP, County Jails, and CHR is 7 years.
- Sixty-two percent (62%) of IPs housed in RCRP, County Jails, and CHR are serving terms of 5 years or less.



## MINIMUM TERM AT ADMISSION

In New Jersey, since 1979, the courts have utilized mandatory minimum sentences. This means that an incarcerated person must serve the entire minimum sentence before being eligible for parole consideration. Mandatory minimum terms are not reduced by earned credits (commutation, minimum security, or work). The below tables and charts only apply to those with a mandatory minimum term, IPs serving a flat term are excluded.

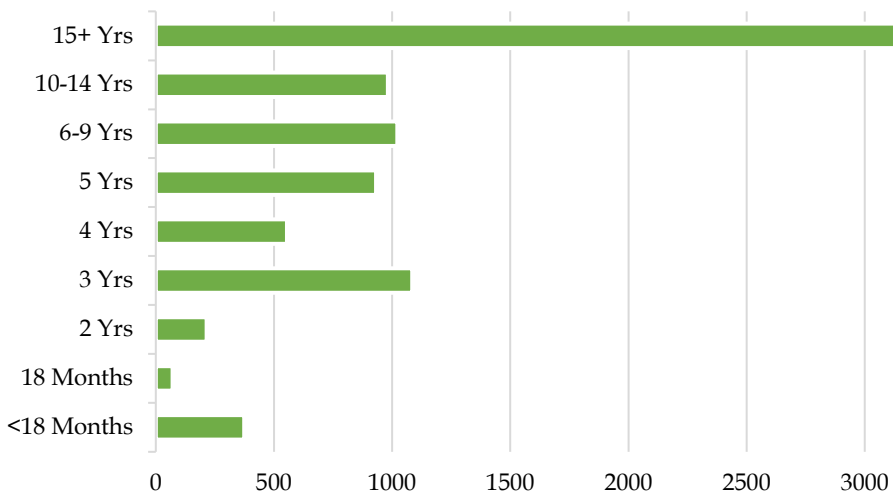

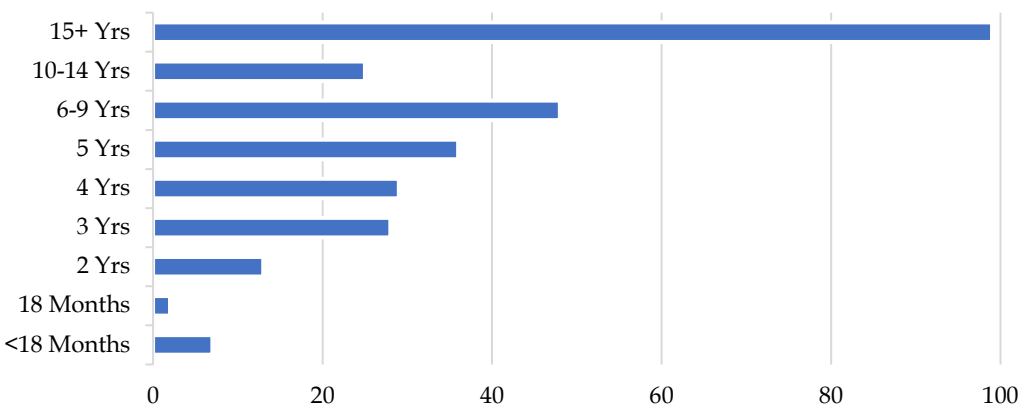

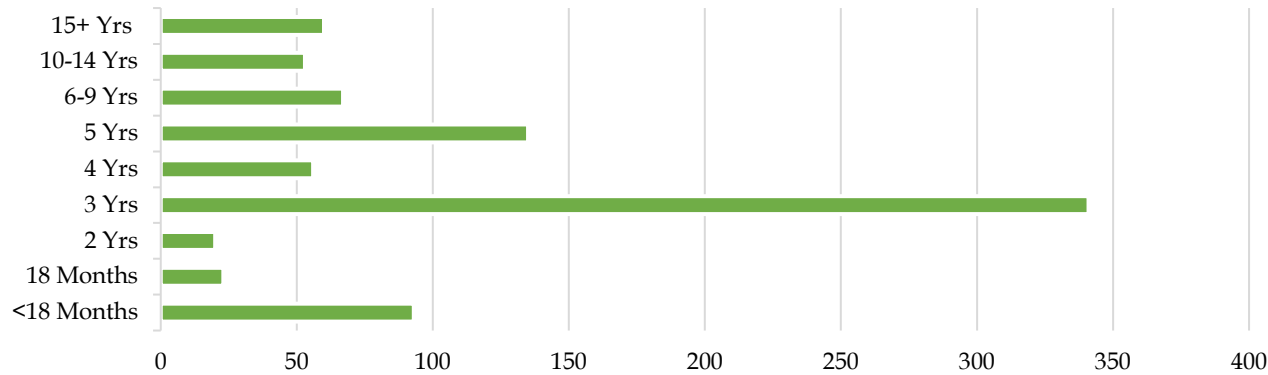

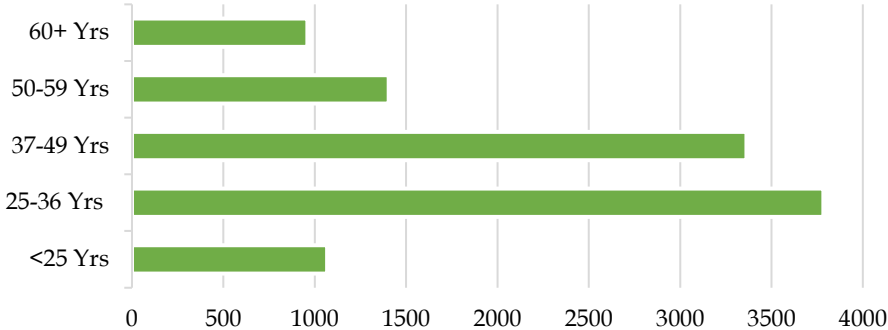

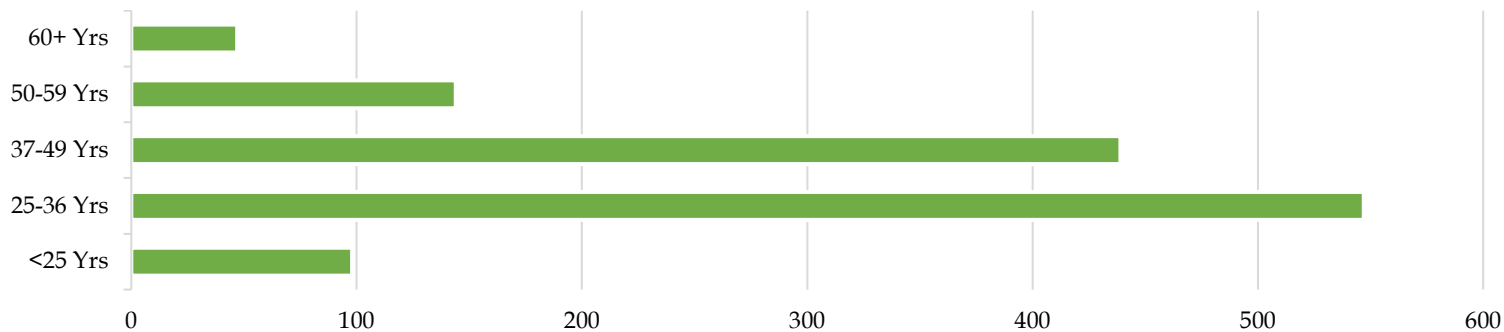

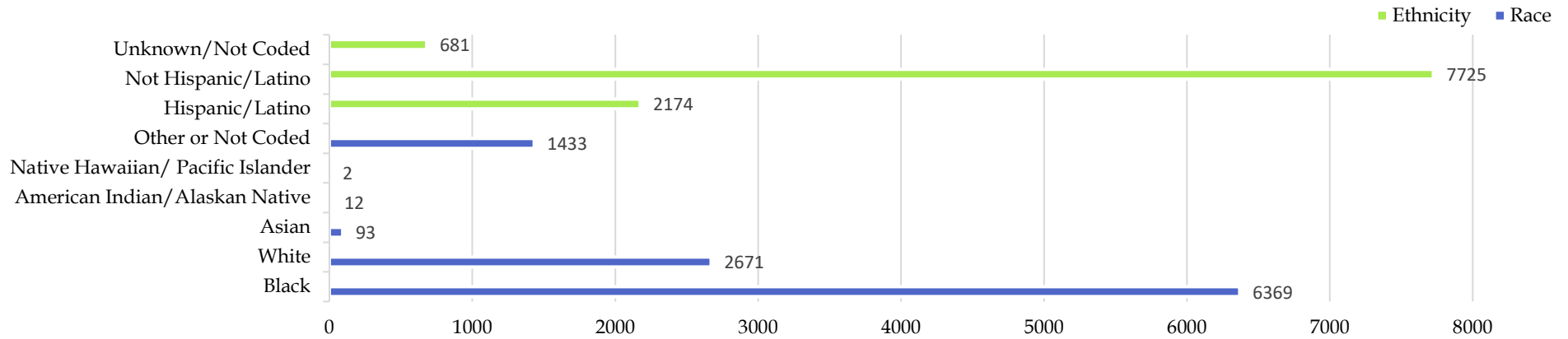

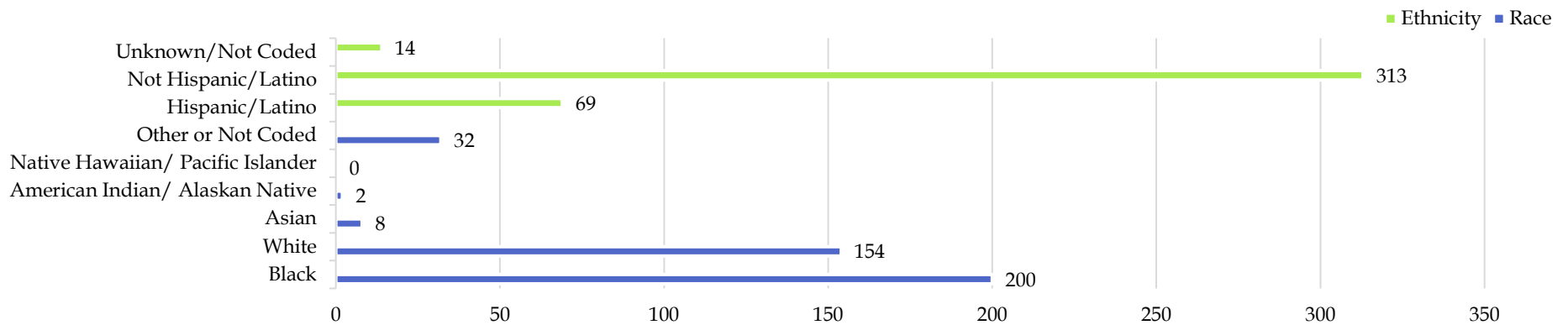

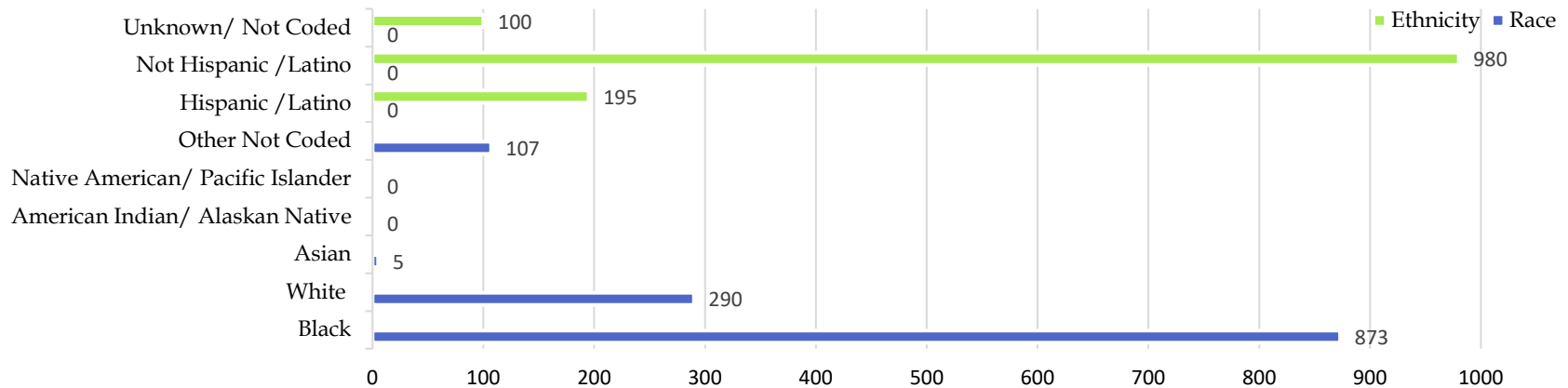
