As a result, the township is requesting the Commission accept the out-of-title work performed by Mr. Kyle Scarpelli, in accordance with *N.J.A.C.* 4A:4-2.6(c).

Brick Township acknowledges Mr. Scarpelli has been employed with the Township in the Information Technology Division since 1999. Sanctioned by the Township, out of business necessity, Mr. Scarpelli has been involved with extensive information technology related work for over four years. Unfortunately, the employee's title has not been changed to adequately reflect the level of work he has been performing.

The Division of Agency Services supports the request of Brick Township to accept the out-oftitle work experience of Mr. Kyle Scarpelli and seeks the Commission's approval of this request.
