# FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

In the Matter of Dennis Morgan, Institutional Trade Instructor 2 Warehousing (PS5039I), South Woods State Prison

Dennis Morgan appeals the determination of the Division of Agency Services (Agency Services) that he did not meet the experience requirements for the promotional examination for Institutional Trade Instructor 2 Warehousing (PS5039I), South Woods State Prison.

The examination at issue was announced with specific requirements that had to be met as of the June 21, 2017 closing date (see attached). A total of three employees applied and one was deemed eligible. Agency Services credited the appellant with 1 year and 10 months of general experience and 3 months of training experience based on his provisional service in the subject title from April 2017 to the June 21, 2017 closing date and pro-rating his 28 hours per week as an Inventory Control for Advance Auto from August 2006 to June 2008, but determined that he lacked 1 year and 2 months of general experience and 9 months of training experience. It found that he had a total of 10 months of general and training experience while on light duty during various short-terms assignments as a Heavy Equipment Operator from May 1999 to April 2017, but these duties would be considered out-of-title work and the appellant's other experience dating back to 1984 in various positions was not primarily focused in the required areas.

On appeal, the appellant submits letters from Jennifer Caignon, Manager 2, Human Resources and J. Edward Volovar, Jr., Industrial Manager 1, who confirm that the appellant, while on light duty for a total of 10 months as a Heavy Equipment Operator, performed the required general and training duties.

# CONCLUSION

N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a) provides that applicants shall meet all requirements specified in the promotional announcement by the closing date. N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(c) provides that, except when permitted for good cause, applicants for promotional examinations with open-competitive requirements may not use experience gained as a result of out-of-title work to satisfy the requirements for admittance to the examination or for credit in the examination process. N.J.A.C. 4A:1-1.2(c) states that the Civil Service Commission (Commission) may relax a rule for good cause in order to effectuate the purposes of Title 11A, New Jersey Statutes.

Initially, it is noted that Agency Services correctly determined that the appellant was not eligible for the subject examination. The appellant had 1 year and 10 months of general experience and 3 months of training experience based on his provisional service in the subject title and his pro-rated part-time experience as an Inventory Control. However, the appellant's 10 months of general and training experience as a Heavy Equipment Operator would be out-of-title work and his other experience was not primarily focused on the required duties. However, Ms. Caignon and Mr. Volovar confirm that the appellant performed the required general and training duties while on light duty as a Heavy Equipment Operator. Further, the appellant gained additional general and training experience while serving after the closing date and he continues to serve provisionally in the title under test. Moreover, the record evidences that list is incomplete as there is only one name on the eligible list. Therefore, under these circumstances, good cause exists to accepts the appellant's out-of-title work and relax the provisions of N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a) and accept his provisional service in the subject title after the closing date, for eligibility purposes only, and admit him to the subject examination.

# ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that the appeal be granted and Dennis Morgan's application be processed for prospective employment opportunities only.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.

Experience: Three (3) years of experience in the warehouse and/or commissary trades which include the receipt, recording, storage and distribution of varied types of equipment, materials, and supplies, one (1) year of which shall have been in the training of new workers.

License: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position. The responsibility for ensuring at employees possess the required motor vehicle license, commensurate with the class and type of vehicles they operate, rests with the Appointing Authority
