# FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

In the Matter of Ronald Breuer, Supervisor Public Works (PM1732U), Linden

**Examination Appeal**

Ronald Breuer appeals the determination of the Division of Agency Services (Agency Services) that he was below the minimum requirements in experience for the promotional examination for Supervisor Public Works (PM1732U), Linden.

The examination at issue was announced with specific requirements that had to be met as of the August 22, 2016 closing date (see attached). A total of four employees applied for the subject examination and three were deemed eligible. Certification PL170074 was issued and the three eligibles were appointed to the subject title.

On appeal, the appellant presents that he has over 27 years working for the appointing authority. He provides examples of street maintenance and repair work that he performed while working in the Traffic and Maintenance Division. Additionally, the appellant states, while working in the Recycling Center in the winter months, he snowplowed city parking lots and repaired city property and streets.

### **CONCLUSION**

N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a) provides that applicants shall meet all requirements specified in the promotional announcement by the closing date. N.J.A.C. 4A:1-1.2(c) states that the Civil Service Commission (Commission) may relax a rule for good cause in order to effectuate the purposes of Title 11A, New Jersey Statutes.

Initially, Agency Services correctly determined that the appellant did not meet the required experience as his primary duties as a Municipal Recycling Coordinator from February 2012 to the August 22, 2016 closing date and a Laborer 1 from March 1994 to February 2012 involved recycling and sanitation work. However, as a Traffic Maintenance Worker from November 1990 to March 1994, the appellant's primary duties involved street and repair maintenance. Additionally, even in the appellant's other positions, some of his duties involved street repair and Therefore, although the appellant's work experience does not precisely mirror the requirements contained in the announcement, the Commission is satisfied that the totality of Mr. Breuer's work involving street repair and maintenance since November 1990, as well as his provisional service in the subject title, which began in January 2017, warrants his admission to the subject examination. Additionally, the list is incomplete as there are no names currently on the eligible list. Therefore, under these circumstances, good cause exists to relax the provisions of N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a) and accept the totality of Mr. Breuer's experience, including his experience after the closing date, and admit him to the subject examination.

#### ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that this appeal be granted and Ronald Breuer's application be processed for prospective employment opportunities only.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.
